

ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIPS (2011)

1. Number

Údarás na hOllscoile offers Scholarships to entrants to the full-time primary degree courses offered in the University as set out below. The Scholarships may be held with other Scholarships or Grants awarded by the University or by an external body.

2. Value

The value of each Scholarship in 2011/12 will be €1,700.00.

3. Tenure

The Scholarships will be tenable only at National University of Ireland, Galway for the First Year of any full-time primary degree course offered by the University, and only in the Session for which they are offered.

4. Condition of Award

To register as a student of the University in the College in which the Scholarship is being awarded by the due registration date. Failure to complete the registration requirement and remain registered until at least 1st March of the year in which the Scholarship is awarded will render the student ineligible without further notice.

5. Payment of the Scholarship

If the holder withdraws from the Course for which she/he has registered (*see under 4 above*) or fails to continue throughout the Session to meet the attendance and other requirements of the course, she/he will be required to repay to the University the whole or any part of the Scholarship as the Finance/Resource Committee of Údarás na hOllscoile may decide.

6. Basis of Award

6.1 The Scholarships will be awarded on the results taken in any one year of the Leaving Certificate Examination of the Department of Education and Skills, except to Medicine. "A" Level applicants from Northern Ireland who achieve the grades of A*A*AB in their best four subjects attained at one sitting, will also be awarded a scholarship, except for applicants to the College of Medicine.

6.2 In the case of the Leaving Certificate Examination the Scholarship will be awarded in accordance with the following Scheme:-

- (i) Not more and not less than six of those subjects accepted by the National University of Ireland for Matriculation registration will be taken into account.
- (ii) Scores will be determined by applying values as follows: A1="100," A2="90," B1="85," B2="80," B3="75," C1="70," C2="65," C3="60," D1="55," D2="50," D3="45" to higher levels respectively; and scores of A1="60," A2="50," B1="45," B2="40," B3="35" to ordinary levels: no bonus points will be added for any subjects.
- (iii) In September 2011 scholarships will be awarded to entrants admitted with minimum points scores as set out in the following table.
