It tells the story of Mrs C, who wants a baby but not a Christmas tree. B wants a real hairdressers' scissors and a wife. D wants a snow globe and "a big head of dirty auld curls". All of them want their own place in the world. And if they can't find it, they'll create one of their own.

Join B and D in the care home where they are resident, and where Mrs C is a carer, on their special - "very fecking special" - journey towards happiness.

Presented by the Abbey Theatre, *B for Baby* is a sharp-witted new play by Carmel Winters.

Carmel Winters was born in Cork and studied Drama and English at Trinity College Dublin. Her debut feature film 'Snap', which she wrote and directed, received its premiere at the 2010 Tribeca Film Festival in New York and went on to win the prestigious Variety Critics Choice Award at the Karlovy-Vary International Film Festival in the Czech Republic. 'B for Baby', is her first full-length play.
