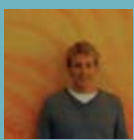

What is the B.Sc. in Business Information Systems

Business Information Systems (BIS) is a four-year undergraduate degree programme offered through the School of Business and Economics at NUI Galway. The programme examines, from a business perspective, the use and management of technology in modern business environments.

It mixes business subjects such as Accounting, Economics and Marketing with technology –focused subjects such as Databases, Systems Analysis and Networks. It also blends business and technology by providing knowledge and skills in traditional business organisation and management, together with skills and abilities in the enabling and underlying technologies upon which organisations are becoming more and more reliant.

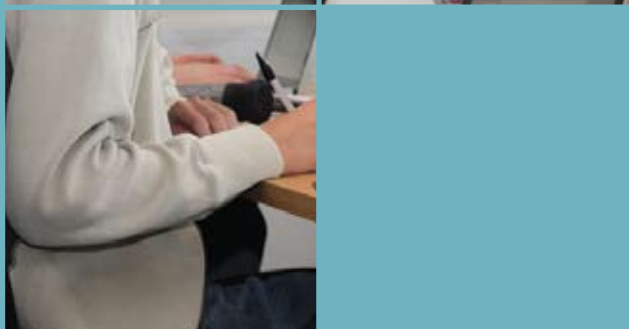
