



B. COMM. (INTERNATIONAL) WITH GERMAN

The B.Comm. (International) with German is a designated four-year degree programme with the language element forming a substantial part of this course. Commerce students who take German have **6 contact hours per week**.

In First Year the language element accounts for 10 ECTS out of 60 ECTS.

In Second and Final Year language modules account for 20 ECTS out of 60 ECTS.

As this degree is an international programme the course incorporates a year abroad at one of six German/Austrian universities as part of the SOCRATES/ERASMUS exchange.

Students must acquire 40 ECTS during their academic study in Germany/Austria to be able to continue into Final Year Commerce/German.

The course is on offer to students who achieve at least a **C3** or better in German at Leaving Certificate Honours Level. Class size is limited to 15 students in First Year.

Please note that first year students of the general B. Comm. programme can also study German at Beginner's OR Advanced Level. After passing their first year German examinations successfully, and after consultation with the programme coordinator, they have the option to transfer to second year B. Comm. (International) German.

In general, students of the B.Comm.(International) German programme graduate with H1 or H2.1 (first and higher second class honours) degrees. They are employed in a variety of areas such as higher management, marketing, human resource management, accounting, diplomatic service, corporate sector etc.

At present, graduates work for the European Central Bank (Frankfurt), Adidas (Germany), Siemens (Munich), the European Commission (Brussels), Aer Lingus (Middle East), national and multi-national finance or accountancy firms as well as insurance companies (Allianz & Canada Life) and banks in Ireland and abroad.

Every year many graduates also enroll successfully in postgraduate programmes in Ireland and Germany.
