





We understand that people might want to bring a supporter to clinic and we are happy for them to do that.


How do you get an appointment?

What happens in the meeting?

1	Before the meeting we will send you all the information you need to take part in the meeting online
	We can help you test this before the meeting or explain how it works if you haven't used it before.



	We might write some things down in case we need to find out something else for you but we won't write down anything that means other people know who said these things.
	We sometimes use these notes to tell students about the types of questions that come up at clinic and teach them who to answer them.
CONFIDENTIAL	If we do that we will never say who had the question or problem, where they lived or anything that might tell people who they are.
Thursday F S S S	Sometimes we might have to have another meeting to answer all your questions, if this happens we will talk about when this meeting will happen or how we can talk to you before we finish.
