## HIGH DEPENDENCY MATERNITY CARE

The aim of this Professional Credit Award module is to improve midwives' acute care knowledge in the following subject areas:

Unit 1 – High dependency care in context

Unit 2 – Principles of haemodynamic and respiratory monitoring in the midwifery client

Unit 3 – Medical complications of pregnancy 1: Diabetic disorders; Haematological complications; Septic shock

Unit 4 – Medical complications of pregnancy 2: Cardiac disease; Hypertensive disorders; Liver disorders of pregnancy

Unit 5 – Professional issues and real-life case studies designed to utilise decision making and critical thinking skills

- Suited to midwives working in maternity services (public, private or voluntary) anywhere in Ireland.
- Module starts in **January 2025** and is delivered by e-learning and 3 workshop days at University of Galway over a 12-week period. Orientation day is 9<sup>th</sup> January 2025; workshop days are 6<sup>th</sup> February and 6<sup>th</sup> March 2025.
- Students may continue to work in their practice setting and apply their learning to practice, thus maximising the impact of the module on client care and service delivery.
