ACHT CHOLÁISTE PHRÍOMH-SCOILE NA GAILLIMHF, 1929 UNIVERSITY COLLEGE GALWAY STATUTE CLI

We, the Governing Body of University College, Galway, under and by virtue of the powers in that behalf conferred on us by above Acts, DO by this present instrument under the Seal of University College, Galway, make the Statute contained in the Schedule hereto for the general government of the said College

Given under the Common Seal of University College, Galway, this third day of December, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty.

SCHEDULE - STATUTE CLI

All previous Statutes of University College, Galway, shall be read and construed with the alterations, additions and modifications hereinafter set forth.

CHAPTER I DEPARTMENT OF CHEMISTRY

- 1. There is hereby established a Departmental Committee in the Department of Chemistry
- 2. The members of the aforesaid Departmental Committee shall be the full-time academic staff of the Department of Chemistry.
- 3. The functions of the aforesaid Departmental Committee shall be to advise the Head of the Department of Chemistry on the general organisation and development of the Department, on the allocation of funds for research and other purposes, and on periodic review of courses. The Committee shall meet at least once per term.
- 4. The Professor of Chemistry, the Professor of Inorganic Chemistry (within the Department of Chemistry) and the holder of any Professorship hereafter established in the Department of Chemistry whose statutory terms so provide may be in rotation Head of the

Department of Chemistry for a period of three years. The scheme of rotation shall be as agreed between the Professors, in the absence of agreement between them, the rotation shall be as determined by the Governing Body on the recommendation of the President.

5 Except as may be provided for by agreement in future, existing members of the fulltime academic staff of the Department of Chemistry shall carry out their duties in the manner prescribed under existing statutes and conditions of appointment.

CHAPTER II

1 The Professorship of Physical Chemistry (in the Department of Chemistry) is hereby extinguished and in lieu thereof there shall be established in the College in the Department of Chemistry in the event of its institution by the Senate of the National University of Ireland the following full-time post

PROFESSORSHIP (NO. 2) OF CHEMISTRY

2. On the occurence of a vacancy in the Professorship of Inorganic Chemistry (within the Department of Chemistry) the said Professorship shall thereupon be extinguished and in lieu thereof there shall be established in the College in the Department of Chemistry in the event of its institution by the Senate of the National University of Ireland the following full-time post:

PROFESSORSHIP (NO. 3) OF CHEMISTRY

- 3 The annual stipend attaching to each of the foregoing Professorships shall be the same as that attaching from time to time to the full-time Professorships of the College.
- 4. The Holder of each of the foregoing Professorships shall, subject to good conduct and the due fulfilment of his duties, continue in office until he shall have attained the age of sixty-five years, and may thereafter be continued in office for five further years PROVIDED that such further continuance in office be recommended to the Senate of the National University of Ireland by the Governing Body with the approval of the President and be sanctioned annually by the said Senate.
- 5. (a) The foregoing Professorships shall be pensionable offices within the meaning of Chapter XXV of Statute XVII of University College, Galway, and the amendments thereto and shall be annexed to the appropriate Table of the Pension Scheme. The Holder of each of the foregoing Professorships shall be entitled to payment of both Pension and Gratuity under, and in accordance with, the provisions of Chapter II and Chapter III of Statute XXXVI of University

College, Gaiway and the Statutes of the College. (b) The annual stipend for the purpose of calculating pension and gratuity in accordance with the relevant provisions of existing statutes of the College shall be that payable at the date of retirement or death of the Holder pursuant to the provisions of Section 3 of this Chapter. (c) There shall be paid annually into the Pension Fund an additional sum equivalent to 15% of the stipend attaching to each of the foregoing Professorships for the purpose of providing such Pension and Gratuity as aforesaid. 6 The holder of each of the foregoing Professorships may be in rotation Head of the Department of Chemistry for a period of three years in accordance with the scheme set out in Section 4 of Chapter I of this Statute. CHAPTER III 1. Nothing herein contained shall affect any appointment made, right acquired or act done under any previous Statute of the College 2. This Statute shall come into operation on the third day of December, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty and may be cited as Statute CLI, University College, Galway, or Stat.
