WE, the Governing Body of University College, Galway, under and by virtue of the powers in that behalf conferred on us by above Acts, DO by this present instrument under the seal of University College, Galway, make the Statute contained in the Schedule hereto for the general government of the said College.

Given under the Common Seal of University College, Galway, this twenty-eighth day of February, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty.

SCHEDULE—STATUTE CXLVII

All previous Statutes of University College, Galway, shall be read and construed with the alterations, additions and modifications hereinafter set forth.

CHAPTER I

STIPENDS: INTERIM DEVLIN AWARD

1. Notwithstanding anything contained in any previous Statute of the College, the stipends attached to the Offices of the President, Secretary-Bursar, Academic Secretary, Librarian, full-time Professorships, full-time Associate Professorships, Associate Secretaryships, full-time Lectureships, part-time Professorships and part-time Lectureships shall be increased by 8.5% as from the 26th day of June, 1978 to take account of increases granted in the Public Sector as a result of the interim award recommended by the Devlin Review Body on Higher Remuneration in the Public Sector.
2. The Governing Body shall have power to round to the nearest pound the amounts of all stipends in which an increase is provided in this Chapter.

CHAPTER II

AGREEMENT ON PAY POLICY 1979

1. Notwithstanding anything contained in any previous Statute of the College, the stipends and allowances attached to the Offices of the President, Secretary-Bursar, Academic Secretary, Librarian, full-time Professorships, full-time Associate Professorships, Associate Secretaryships, full-time Lectureships, shall, as from the 1st day of June, 1979, be increased by 9%, subject to a minimum of £286 per annum. This increase shall be known as the Agreement on Pay Policy 1979 First Phase increase and shall apply for a period of nine months until the 29th day of February, 1980.
2. As from the 1st day of March, 1980, the stipends and allowances attached to the offices mentioned in Section I of this Chapter shall be increased by 2%, together with 1% for each 1% rise over 7% in the Consumer Price Index for the period mid-November 1978 to mid-November 1979, subject to a limit of 5%, and a further £31.20 per annum for each 1% rise above 12% in the Consumer Price Index in the period mid-November 1978 to mid-November 1979, subject to a limit of £124.80 per annum. The minimum increase under this Phase, which shall be known as the Agreement on Pay Policy 1979 Second Phase, shall be £156 per annum, and it shall apply for a period of six months from the 1st day of March, 1980 until the 31st day of August, 1980.
3. The Governing Body shall have power to round to the nearest pound the amounts of all stipends and allowances in which an increase is provided in this Chapter.

CHAPTER III

AGREEMENT ON PAY POLICY 1979—

PART-TIME POSTS

1. Notwithstanding anything contained in any previous Statute of the College, the stipends attached to each part-time Professorship and each part-time Lectureship shall, as from the 1st day of June, 1979, be increased by 9%, subject to a minimum sum per annum in respect to each post as set out in Table A to this Chapter. This increase shall be known as the Agreement on Pay Policy 1979 First Phase increase, and shall apply for a period of nine months until the 29th day of February, 1980.
2. As from the 1st day of March 1980, the stipend attached to each part-time Professorship and each part-time Lectureship shall be increased by 2%, together with 1% for each 1% rise above 7% in the Consumer Price Index in the period mid-November 1978 to mid-November 1979, subject to a limit of

5% and a further amount per annum, as set out in respect to each post in Table A to this Chapter, for each 1% rise above 12% in the Consumer Price Index in the period mid-November 1978 to mid-November 1979, subject to the limit per annum set out in respect to each post in the said Table. The minimum increase under this Phase, which shall be known as the Agreement on Pay Policy 1979 Second Phase, shall be the amount per annum set out in respect to each post in the said Table and it shall apply for a period of six months from the 1st day of March, 1980 until the 31st day of August 1980.

3. The Governing Body shall have power to round to the nearest pound the amounts of all stipends in which an increase is provided in this Chapter.

CHAPTER IV

CHILD ALLOWANCE

1. The amount of the annual non-pensionable allowance payable to members of staff appointed on or before the 2nd day of October, 1978 in respect of each child under the age of 18 years shall, as from the 1st day of March 1979, be:
 - (a) in respect of a child of a full-time Statutory Officer, Professor, Associate Professor, Associate Secretary, Lecturer £102 per annum
 - (b) in respect of a child of a part-time Professor £51 per annum
 - (c) in respect of a child of a part-time Lecturer £38 per annum

2. The amount of the said allowance shall, as from the 1st day of June 1979, be:
 - (a) in respect of a child of a full-time Statutory Officer, Professor, Associate Professor, Associate Secretary, Lecturer £103 per annum
 - (b) in respect of a child of a part-time Professor £52 per annum
 - (c) in respect of a child of a part-time Lecturer £39 per annum

3. For the future, the amount of the said allowance shall be increased in the case of full-time members of staff in accordance with the monetary increase in the child allowance payable in the Civil Service and in the case of part-time members of staff pro-rata.

CHAPTER V

BACKDATING OF ABOLITION OF MARRIAGE ALLOWANCE

1. Section I of Chapter I of Statute CXXX is hereby amended by the substitution of the words "as from the 31st day of December, 1975" for the words "as from the first day of July, 1977".
2. Holders of the Offices of President, Secretary-Bursar, Academic Secretary, Librarian, full-time Professorships, full-time Associate Professorships, Associate Secretaryships and full-time Lectureships who were unmarried in the period 31st December, 1975 to 30th June, 1977 shall receive a gratuity equivalent to the additional amount which they would have received in that period if they had been in receipt of a marriage allowance. Holders of the foregoing Offices who married during the period 31st December, 1975 to 30th June, 1977 shall receive a gratuity equivalent to the additional amount which they would have received if they had been in receipt of a marriage allowance in the period from 31st December, 1975 to the date of their marriage.

3. The amount due in respect of each person who is entitled under Section 2 of this Chapter to such gratuity shall be divided into three equal instalments and paid in such instalments annually, the first such instalment being payable on 1st July 1979.

CHAPTER VI

PENSIONS AND GRATUITIES

1. For the purpose of calculating the pension and gratuity respectively payable on the retirement and on the death or retirement of the President, the annual stipend deemed to be payable at date of retirement or at date of death shall be £22,077 from the 1st day of June 1979 and, as from the 1st day of March 1980, shall be as calculated in accordance with the provisions of Section 2 of Chapter II above.

For the purpose of calculating the pension and gratuity respectively payable on the retirement and on the death or retirement of the Lady Superintendent, the annual stipend payable to her at date of retirement or at date of death shall be deemed to be £8,777 from the 1st day of June 1979 and, as from the 1st day of March 1980, shall be as calculated in accordance with the provisions of Section 2 of Chapter II above.

CHAPTER VII

1. Nothing herein contained shall affect any appointment made, right acquired or act done under any previous Statute of the College.
2. This Statute shall come into operation on the twenty-eighth day of February, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty and may be cited as Statute CXLVII, University College, Galway, or Stat. CXLVII, Univ. Coll., Galway.
