STATUTE CXXI

WE, the Governing Body of University College, Galway, under and by virtue of the powers in that behalf conferred on us by the above Acts DO by this present instrument under the Seal of University College, Galway, make the Statute contained in the Schedule hereto for the general government of the said College.

Given under the Common Seal of University College, Galway, this Twenty-ninth day of June, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-seven.

SCHEDULE—STATUTE CXXI

All previous Statutes of University College, Galway, shall be read and construed with the alterations, additions and modifications hereinafter set forth.

CHAPTER I

STIPENDS AND ALLOWANCES ATTACHED TO
STATUTORY OFFICES, PROFESSORSHIPS AND
LECTURESHIPS

1. Notwithstanding anything contained in any previous Statute of the College, the stipends and marriage allowances attached to the Offices of President, Secretary-Bursar, Academic Secretary, Librarian, full-time Professorships, full-time Associate Professorships, Associate Secretaryships and full-time lectureships shall
 - (a) as and from the first day of April, 1977 be increased by whichever of the following two amounts is the greater:
 - (i) two and one half per cent; plus £1 per week, subject to a maximum increase of £4.13 per week.
 - or
 - (ii) £2 per week.This increase shall be known as the First Phase of the Employer-Trade Union National Agreement 1977 increase.

(b) as and from the first day of November, 1977, be increased by whichever of the following two amounts is the greater:

(i) two and one half per cent; plus £1 per week, subject to a maximum increase of £4.23 per week.

or

(ii) £2 per week.

This increase shall be known as the Second Phase of the Employer-Trade Union National Agreement 1977 increase.

2. The Governing Body shall have power to round to the nearest pound the amounts of all Stipends in which an increase is provided in this Chapter.

CHAPTER II

1. Notwithstanding anything contained in any previous Statute of the College, the annual Stipend attached to each part-time Professorship and each part-time Lectureship shall, as and from the effective dates listed below, be increased to the sums set opposite the respective titles of the said Professorships and Lectureships as follows:

The increases shall be known as the Employer-Trade Union National Agreement 1977 increases.

CHAPTER III

PENSIONS AND GRATUITIES

1. For the purpose of calculating the pension and gratuity respectively payable on the retirement and on the death or retirement of the President, the annual stipend deemed to be payable at date of retirement or at date of death shall be £16,723 as and from the first day of April 1977 and £16,944 as and from the first day of November 1977.

For the purpose of calculating the pension and gratuity respectively payable on the retirement and on the death or retirement of the Lady Superintendent the annual stipend payable to her at date of retirement or at date of death, shall be (deemed to be) £6,366 as and from the first day of April, 1977, and £6,577 as and from the first day of November 1977.

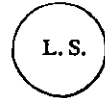
2. Instead of the sums now being paid annually into the Statutory Pensionable Officers' Pension Fund and into Pension Fund No. 2, there shall henceforth be paid and transferred to the said funds out of the annual Income granted by the Oireachtas for the general purposes of the College or out of any other monies of the College applicable thereto such sums as an Actuary shall certify to be necessary for providing Pensions and Gratuities.
3. On the coming into operation of this Statute, former holders of Pensionable Professorships, Pensionable Lectureships or Pensionable Offices, or the Widows of such persons, shall be entitled to have their current pensions calculated and paid in the manner and subject to the Conditions prescribed by Statute LI of University College, Galway, subject to the provisions of Statute LXXII, Statute LXXX, and (where applicable) of Statute LXVI and of Chapter I of Statute LXXIV.

CHAPTER IV

1. Nothing herein contained affect any appointment made, right acquired of act done under any previous Statute of the College.

2. This Statute shall come into operation on the Twenty-ninth day of June, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-seven and may be cited as Statute CXXI University College, Galway, or Stat. CXXI Univ. Coll., Galway.
