UNIVERSITY COLLEGE, GALWAY STATUTE CXXXIX

WE, the Governing Body of University College, Galway under and by virtue of the powers in that behalf conferred on us by above Acts, DO by this present instrument under the Seal of University College, Galway, make the Statute contained in the Schedule hereto, for the general government of the said College.

SCHEDULE STATUTE CXXXIX

All previous Statutes of University College, Galway, shall be read and construed with the alterations, additions and modifications hereinafter set forth.

CHAPTER I

PROFESSORSHIP (PART TIME) OF COMMON LAW

- 1. The Professorship of Law and Jurisprudence shall henceforth be known as the Professorship (Part-time) of Common Law.
- 2. The annual stipend attaching to the foregoing Part-time Professorship shall be £2,500.
- 3. (a) The foregoing Professorship shall be a pensionable office within the meaning of Chapter XXV of Statute XVII of University College, Galway, and the amendments thereto and shall be annexed to the appropriate Table of the Pension Scheme. The holder of the said Professorship shall be entitled to payment of both Pension and Gratuity under and in accordance with the provisions of Chapter II and Chapter III of Statute XXXVI of University College, Galway, and the Statutes of the College.
 - (b) The annual stipend for the purpose of calculating Pension and Gratuity in accordance with the re'evant provisions of existing Statutes of the College shall be that payable at date of retirement or death of the holder pursuant to the provisions of the relevant Sections of this Chapter.
 - (c) There shall be paid annually into the Pension Fund an additional sum equivalent to 15%, of the stipend attaching to the Professorship for the purpose of providing such Pension and Gratuity as aforesaid.

CHAPTER II PROFESSORSHIP OF LAW—DUTIES

1. Subject to review by the Governing Body following consultation with the Professor of Law, the relevant Faculties, and the Academic Council, the Professor of Law shall, in addition to every other function specifically assigned to him by statute and conditions of appointment, be responsible for the general direction of courses, in Law and Legal subjects.

CHAPTER III

- 1 Nothing herein contained shall affect any appointment made, right acquired or act done under any previous Statute of the College
- 2. This Statute shall come into operation on the twenty first day of March, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-nine and may be cited as Statute CXXXIX, University College, Galway, or Stat. CXXXIX, Univ. Coll., Galway.
