STATUTE CXXX

WE, the Governing Body of University College, Galway, under and by virtue of the powers in that behalf conferred on us by above Acts, DO by this present instrument under the Seal of University College, Galway, make the Statute contained in the Schedule hereto, for the general government of the said College.

SCHEDULE—STATUTE CXXX

All previous Statutes of University College, Galway, shall be read and construed with the alterations, additions and modifications hereinafter set forth.

CHAPTER I

ABOLITION OF NON-PENSIONABLE MARRIAGE
ALLOWANCE AND CHILD ALLOWANCE

1. The provisions of all previous Statutes of the College for payment of an annual non-pensionable allowance to a married man in respect of his wife and to a married woman in respect of her husband, are, as from the first day of July, 1977, hereby revoked.
2. The annual stipends, as regards stipends on appointment, points on scales and maxima attached to the offices of President, Secretary-Bursar, Academic Secretary, Librarian, full-time Professorships, full-time Associate Professorships, Associate Secretaryships and full-time Lectureships shall be increased as follows:
from 1st July, 1977 to 31st October, 1977 by £157 per annum.
from 1st November, 1977 by £160 per annum.

3. Notwithstanding anything contained in any previous Statute of the College, any full-time Statutory Officer, Professor, Associate Professor, Associate Secretary and Lecturer, and any part-time Professor and Lecturer appointed after the 2nd October, 1978, shall not be entitled to payment of an annual non-pensionable allowance in respect of a child or children. This shall not apply to persons appointed after 2nd October, 1978, who immediately prior to that appointment held an appointment in the College which had an entitlement to such allowance.

CHAPTER II

ADJUSTMENTS CONSEQUENTIAL ON THE ANTI-DISCRIMINATION (PAY) ACT, 1974

1. Subject to the provisions in Chapter I of this Statute, there shall be payable, as from the 31st day of December, 1975, or from the date of appointment if later, an annual non-pensionable allowance, of amount set out in Section 2 of this Chapter, to each Statutory Officer, Professor, Associate Professor, Associate Secretary and Lecturer who is a married woman in respect of each child under the age of 18 years, provided that her husband is not eligible for an allowance for the same child arising from his employment in the College or in the public sector. Where a husband and a wife are eligible for an allowance arising from their employment in the College or in the public sector in respect of the same child, the child allowance payable shall be reduced pro-rata. The allowance shall continue to be payable in respect of any child receiving full-time education until such child attains the age of twenty-one years.
2. The annual non-pensionable allowance referred to in Section I of this Chapter shall be—

CHAPTER III

EMPLOYER-TRADE UNION NATIONAL AGREEMENT, 1978

1. Notwithstanding anything contained in any previous statute of the College, the stipends attached to the Offices of the President, Secretary-Bursar, Academic Secretary, Librarian, full-time Professorships, full-time Associate Professorships, Associate Secretaryships and full-time Lectureships shall.

- (a) as from the first day of March, 1978, be increased by whichever of the following amounts is the greater:
- (i) 8 per cent; or
 - (ii) £3.50 per week.
- (b) as from the first day of March, 1979, be increased by 2 per cent.
2. The increase specified at (a) above shall be known as the Employer Trade Union National Agreement, 1978, Phase I increase. The increase specified at (b) above shall be known as the Employer Trade Union National Agreement, 1978, Phase II increase.
 3. The Governing Body shall have power to round to the nearest pound the amounts of all stipends in which an increase is provided in this Chapter.

CHAPTER IV
EMPLOYER-TRADE UNION NATIONAL AGREEMENT,
1978—PART-TIME POSTS

- I. Notwithstanding anything contained in any previous Statute of the College, the annual Stipend attached to each part-time Professorship and each part-time Lectureship shall as and from the effective dates listed below, be increased to the sums set opposite the respective titles of the said Professorships and Lectureships as follows:

The increases shall be known as the Employer-Trade Union National Agreement, 1978, increases.

CHAPTER V

PENSIONS AND GRATUITIES

1. For the purpose of calculating the pension and gratuity respectively payable on the retirement and on the death or retirement of the President, the annual stipend deemed to be payable at date of retirement or at date of death shall be £18,300 from the first day of March, 1978, and £18,666 as and from the first day of March, 1979.

For the purpose of calculating the pension and gratuity respectively payable on the retirement and on the death or retirement of the Lady Superintendent the annual stipend payable to her at date of retirement or at date of death, shall be deemed to be £7,103 as and from the first day of March, 1978 and £7,245 as and from the first day of March, 1979.

2. Instead of the sums now being paid annually into the Statutory Pensionable Officers' Pension Fund and into Pension Fund No. 2, there shall henceforth be paid and transferred to the said funds out of the annual Income granted by the Oireachtas for the general purposes of the College or out of any other monies of the College applicable thereto annual sums equivalent to 15 per cent of the stipends and salaries of the pensionable members of staff included in each scheme.
3. On the coming into operation of this Statute, former holders of Pensionable Professorships, Pensionable Lectureships or Pensionable Offices, or the Widows of such persons, shall be entitled to have their current pensions calculated and paid in the manner and subject to the Conditions prescribed by Statute LI of University College, Galway, subject to the provisions of Statute LXXII, Statute LXXX, and (where applicable) of Statute LXXVI and of Chapter I of Statute LXXXIV.

CHAPTER VI

1. Nothing herein contained shall affect any appointment made, right acquired or act done under any previous Statute of the College.
2. This Statute shall come into operation on the thirtieth day of June, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-eight and may be cited as Statute CXXX University College, Galway, or Stat. CXXX Univ. Coll., Galway.
