### SCHEDULE-STATUTE LXXXVIII

All previous Statutes of University College, Galway, and in particular Statute LXXXV shall be read and construed with the alterations, additions, and modifications hereinafter set forth.

#### CHAPTER I

## ASSOCIATE PROFESSORSHIP OF PHYSIOLOGY ASSOCIATE PROFESSORSHIP OF BOTANY

- 1. Chapter III of Statute LXXXV is hereby rescinded and there shall be established in the College in the event of their institution by the Senate of the National University of Ireland a full-time Associate Professorship of Physiology and a full-time Associate Professorship of Botany.
- 2. The annual stipend attached to the Associate Professorship of Physiology shall be  $\pounds 4,418$ . The annual stipend attached to the Associate Professorship of Botany shall be  $\pounds 4,418$ . The said annual stipends shall be non-incremental.

- 3. The holder of the Associate Professorship of Physiology shall carry out his duties under the direction of the Professor of Physiology. The holder of the Associate Professorship of Botany shall carry out his duties under the direction of the Professor of Botany.
- 4. The holder of each of the foregoing Associate Professorships shall, subject to good conduct and the due fulfilment of his duties, continue in office until he shall have attained the age of sixty-five years and thereafter be continued in office for five further years: PROVIDED THAT such further continuance in office is recommended to the Senate of the National University of Ireland by the Governing Body with the approval of the President of the said College and is sanctioned annually by the said Senate.
- 5. (a) The foregoing Associate Professorships shall be pensionable offices within the meaning of Chapter XXV of Statute XVII of University College, Galway, and the amendments thereto and shall be annexed to the appropriate Table of the Pension Scheme. The holders of the said Associate Professorships shall be entitled to payment of both Pension and Gratuity in accordance with the provisions of Chapter II and Chapter III of Statute XXXVI of University College, Galway, and the Statutes of the College.

- (b) The annual stipends for the purposes of calculating Pensions and Gratuities in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Statutes of the College shall be deemed to be those payable at dates of retirement or death of the holders pursuant to the provisions of Section 2 of this Chapter.
- (c) There shall be paid into the Pension Fund such additional sums as an Actuary shall certify to be necessary for providing such Pensions and Gratuities as aforesaid.
- 6. The holders of the foregoing Associate Professorships shall be entitled to the annual allowances in respect of wives and children pursuant to Statute XXXVII and Statute LV of University College, Galway, as amended by any subsequent Statute of the said College.

#### CHAPTER II

()

- 1. Nothing herein contained shall affect any appointment made, right acquired or act done under any previous Statute of the College.
- 2. This Statute shall come into operation on the 22nd day of November, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy Two and may be cited as Statute LXXXVIII of University College, Galway, or Stat. LXXXVIII Univ. Coll., Galway.
