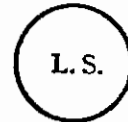

STATUTE LXXXV

WE, the Governing Body of University College, Galway, under and by virtue of the powers in that behalf conferred on us by the above Acts, DO by this present instrument under the Seal of University College, Galway, make the Statute contained in the Schedule hereto for the general government of the said College.

SCHEDULE—STATUTE LXXXV

All previous Statutes of University College, Galway, shall be read and construed with the alterations, additions, and modifications hereinafter set forth.

CHAPTER I

Stipends and Allowances attached to Statutory Offices, Professorships and Lectureships.

1. Notwithstanding anything contained in any previous Statute of the College, the stipends and allowances attached to the Offices, Professorships and Lectureships referred to in Table A and in Table B to this chapter shall, on and from the first day of January 1972, be the stipends and allowances set forth in the said tables.
2. This Chapter shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 31st day of December, 1971.

Table A:

1. The annual stipend of the President shall be £7,389. In addition, he shall be entitled to residence, fuel and light as heretofore valued for pension purposes at £1,188 per annum, and to a non-pensionable allowance of £1,188 in respect of the expenses of his office.

2. The annual stipend of the holder of each of the following full-time offices namely:
 - (a) The office of Secretary-Bursar,
 - (b) The office of Academic Secretary,
 - (c) The office of Librarian,
 shall be £4,053 on appointment, increasing to a maximum of £4,965 by annual increments of £114 for each completed year of service since appointment subject to the provisions, where applicable of Chapter II of Statute LIV of University College, Galway.
3. The annual stipend of the holder of each full-time Professorship shall be £4,053 on appointment, increasing to a maximum of £4,965 by annual increments of £114 for each completed year of service since appointment subject to the provisions, where applicable, of Chapter II of Statute LIV of University College, Galway.
4. The annual stipend of the holder of each full-time Associate Professorship shall be £4,419. The said annual stipend shall be non-incremental.
5. The annual stipend of the holder of each full-time Lectureship shall be £2,757 on appointment increasing to a maximum of £3,837 by annual increments of £108 for each completed year of service since appointment subject to the provisions, where applicable, of Chapter II of Statute LIV of University College, Galway.

Table B:

1. The annual stipend of each part-time Professorship and each part-time Lectureship set-out in this Table shall, as from the first day of January 1972, be the sum set opposite the respective titles of the said Professorships and Lectureships as follows:

CHAPTER II

PENSIONS AND GRATUITIES

1. For the purpose of calculating the pension and gratuity respectively payable on the retirement and on the death or retirement of the President, the annual stipend deemed to be payable at date of retirement or at date of death shall be £8,577.

For the purpose of calculating the pension and gratuity respectively payable on the retirement and on the death or retirement of the Lady Superintendent the annual stipend payable to her at date of retirement or at date of death, shall be deemed to be £3,111.

2. Instead of the sum now being paid annually into the Statutory Pensionable Officers' Pension Fund, there shall henceforth be paid and transferred to the said fund out of the annual Income granted by the Oireachtas for the general purposes of the college or out of any other monies of the College applicable thereto an annual sum of £50,000.
3. On coming into operation of this Statute, former holders of Pensionable Professorships, Pensionable Lectureships or Pensionable Offices shall be entitled to have their current pension calculated and paid in the manner and subject to the conditions prescribed by Statute LI of University College, Galway, subject to the provisions of Statute LXXII, Statute LXXX and (where applicable) of Statute LXVI and of Chapter I of Statute LXXIV.

CHAPTER III

ASSOCIATE PROFESSORSHIP OF PHYSIOLOGY

1. There shall be established in the College in the event of its institution by the Senate of the National University of Ireland a full-time Associate Professorship of Physiology.
2. The annual stipend attached to the Associate Professorship of Physiology shall be £4,419. The said annual stipend shall be non-incremental.
3. The holder of the Associate Professorship of Physiology shall carry out his duties under the direction of the Professor of Physiology.
4. The holder of the foregoing Associate Professorship shall, subject to good conduct and the due fulfilment of his duties, continue in office until he shall have attained the age of sixty-five years and thereafter be continued in office for five further years: PROVIDED THAT such further continuance in office is recommended to the Senate of the National University of Ireland

by the said Governing Body with the approval of the President of the said College and is sanctioned annually by the said Senate.

5. (a) The foregoing Associate Professorship shall be a pensionable office within the meaning of Chapter XXV of Statute XVII of University College, Galway, and the amendments thereto and shall be annexed to the appropriate Table of the Pension Scheme. The holder of the Associate Professorship shall be entitled to payment of both Pension and Gratuity in accordance with the provisions of Chapter II and Chapter III of Statute XXXVI of University College, Galway, and the Statutes of the College.
 - (b) The annual stipend for the purpose of calculating Pension and Gratuity in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Statutes of the College shall be deemed to be that payable at date of retirement or death of the holder pursuant to the provisions of Section 2 of this Chapter.
 - (c) There shall be paid into the Pension Fund such additional sum as an Actuary shall certify to be necessary for providing such Pension and Gratuity as aforesaid.
6. The holder of the Associate Professorship of Physiology shall be entitled to the annual allowances in respect of a wife and children pursuant to Statute XXXVII and Statute LV of University College, Galway, as amended by any subsequent Statute of the said College.

CHAPTER IV

1. Nothing herein contained shall affect any appointment made, right acquired or act done under any previous Statute of the College.
2. This Statute shall come into operation on the Twenty-third day of February, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy Two and may be cited Statute LXXXV of University College, Galway, or Stat. LXXXV Univ. Coll., Galway.
