Can I claim Tax and PRSI Relief on the Amounts Paid by Cheque?

You can apply for tax refund from revenue - the Pensions office will write to revenue confirming the amount paid and provide a copy of the letter to you in support of your refund application. Claims for refunds of PRSI (only allowed to year end 31/12/10) in respect of pension contributions should be made by completing <u>Form CGPRS 1</u> (document link)

Completed forms together with a copy of your P60 for the tax year to which the claim relates should be sent to:

PRSI Refunds Section, Collector-General's Division, Sarsfield House, Limerick.

(Prior to making a claim for a pension PRSI refund, an application for a refund of tax on the pension contributions must be made to the applicant's tax district at the end of the tax year).
