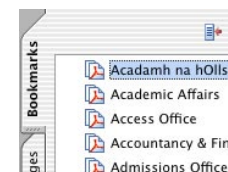

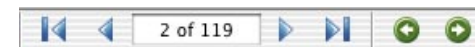
Navigation

Faculty of Arts

The Arts faculty continues to attract high calibre undergraduate and postgraduate students to its programme of offerings. The faculty hosts about 43% of all students - the largest unit in NUI, Galway. In addition to our full-time students, the faculty accommodated over 250 Junior Year Abroad students who registered in the Arts faculty each semester. Total postgraduate numbers in taught and research programmes are being generally maintained. During 2002-2003 the Arts faculty has finalised the delivery of over 10 new postgraduate taught programmes in the current and near future, bringing the menu of offerings to over 30 programmes. Thus the Arts faculty is realising its commitment to the provision of professional/vocational postgraduate qualifications that build on the knowledge and skills base of the undergraduate BA programme. In addition to new permanent academic staff, the faculty was pleased to welcome two Visiting Fellows: Professor Aviva Ben-Ur and Professor JeDon Emmenhauser. With the support of the Arts Council and the faculty's own funds, two Writers-in-Residence were appointed for a fixed-term: Mike McCormack (English) and Pdraig O' Cíobhain, Scríbhneoir Cónaitheach (Gaeilge). Mr John McGahern continued in his appointment as Adjunct Professor in Irish Studies and Mr John Behan as Adjunct Lecturer in Fine Arts.

The publications, presented papers, external academic appointments, distinctions and fellowships contained herein all attest to the range and quality of academic endeavour in Arts.

This year, the Arts faculty commenced the implementation of its Academic Plan 2002-2006. As part of realising the 22 objectives and 75 associated projects the faculty constituted a number of committees, including Student Advisory,

Postgraduate Handbook, Examinations, Tutorials, Research and Student Services Liaison Committees. In addition to the activities of Centres within Arts (Irish Studies, Women's Studies and Human Settlement and Historical Change), just under €2 million in research grants was awarded to individual and departmental research projects within the Arts faculty.

The Arts faculty introduced new evening programmes this year as part of its continuing commitment to Outreach activities. The Evening Diploma/Degree programme in Ennis moved into its third year, with its programmes in archaeology, history and elective programmes in anthropology, film studies, information technology and women's studies. In addition, other programmes continued with their successes this year, including the MA in Writing and the MA in Irish Studies, as well as Diplomas in Italian, Film Studies, English Literature, and Dioplómai I Litríocht na Nua-Ghaeilge.

Overall, the Arts faculty commends this report as confirmation of its role in the academic and cultural life of NUI Galway.
