



**Doctor of Psychological Science  
(Clinical Psychology) 2010**

Applications are invited for the D.Psych.Sc. (Clinical Psychology), a three-year full-time professional training programme in clinical psychology. The programme is accredited by the Psychological Society of Ireland. Applications are invited for the programme commencing in September 2010.

Clinical trainees are currently sponsored by the Health Service Executive (HSE) (salary and fee contribution), with successful graduates contracted to HSE posts for a fixed post-qualification period. Sponsorship funding (salary and fee contribution) is subject to confirmation by the Health Service Executive.

Applicants must, at the time of application, hold a primary degree in psychology or a postgraduate diploma in psychology, recognised by the Psychological Society of Ireland as conferring eligibility for graduate membership of the Society. The degree must (barring exceptional circumstances) be at least at upper second-class honours level. Practical and/or research experience relevant to clinical psychology is also required. Selection will be on the basis of competitive short-listing and interview of applicants. Interviews will take place during May 2010.

Applications should be submitted through the NUI Galway on-line postgraduate applications system ([www.pac.ie/nuig](http://www.pac.ie/nuig)). The programme code is GYA37.

It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that referees' reports reach the Clinical Psychology Secretary (Alma Greally) before interview dates.
