Tim Robinson: Connemara, directed by Pat Collins of Harvest Films, will be shown at 6pm and will be followed by a wine and Irish cheese reception in Sheridans' Wine Bar, Churchyard Street, at 8pm that evening. A brief talk on the history of Irish food produce will also take place on the night, where Dr Frances Fahy will introduce the work of Brídín Carroll who is a doctoral candidate currently working on issues of sustainability and food systems at NUI Galway.

It is also anticipated that a GSI fieldtrip to south Connemara on the following day will also include a visit to *Folding Landscapes*, the home and working studio of Tim and Mairéad Robinson, in Roundstone, Co.
