1. Dial 9 for Outside Line.
2. In an immediate emergency Dial 112/999** and specify the emergency service required
(*Use either number on a land line but only 112 on a mobile phone).
3. For medical emergencies in particular give the details set out in the Pre-Hospital Emergency Care Council's "Red Card" – details underlined apply to all emergencies.
 - Phone number you are calling from
 - Location of Incident
 - Chief complaint
 - Number of patients/people
 - Age (approximate)
 - Gender
 - Conscious? yes/no
 - Breathing normally? yes/no
 - If > 35 years Chest pain? yes/no
 - If trauma Severe bleeding? yes/no
