For the School of Engineering degree programmes, Technology is accepted as a Lab Science subject for Engineering courses GY401 to GY414. Computer Science is accepted as a Lab Science subject for courses in the College of Science and Engineering.

¶ The University holds an Engineering Maths Qualifying Examination in August each year for entry to the Engineering Programmes. Candidates who reach the appropriate standard are deemed to have satisfied the additional Honours Mathematics requirement.
