National University of Ireland Galway is one of Ireland's oldest and most prestigious universities, with a distinguished record in teaching and research. For over 175 years, NUI Galway has been welcoming students and researchers from all over the world. Ideally located in the city of Galway, the university offers a broad range of internationally recognised programmes in a welcoming academic community.

### OUR GLOBAL REPUTATION

Since 2014, NUI Galway has moved up 25 places in the QS World University Rankings, which now positions us at 259 in the world. Both the QS and Times Higher Education Rankings have placed the University in a high position, and we are now counted among the Top Universities in both rankings. In 2019, the new Times Higher Education University Impact Rankings placed NUI Galway 20th in the world for addressing the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goal for Good Health and Wellbeing.

### OUR LOCATION

NUI Galway is uniquely located in a beautiful historic campus in the west coast of Ireland, on the edge of the Wild Atlantic Way coastline and only 2 hours drive from Dublin. The university campus is a 10 minute walk from the centre of Galway City. Galway is Ireland's third largest city, with everything you would want in terms of shopping facilities, theatres, restaurants, music venues, sports facilities.

Galway is a place like no other. Set on the Wild Atlantic Way, on the broad sweep of Galway Bay, Galway is as distinctive as it is beautiful. From this position on the Atlantic edge of Europe, NUI Galway has a proud history of reaching out and connecting with the world. Galway casually combines the energy of a young and diverse population, with the authenticity of a place steeped in history and tradition. We are renowned as a place where arts and culture are celebrated, reinterpreted and shared with the world.

The city is also a cultural hub and has been designated the European Capital of Culture for 2020. Ireland is one of the safest countries in the world according to the Global Peace Index and the Condé Nast Traveler magazine has also voted Galway among the top six friendliest cities in the world!

### LINKS WITH INDUSTRY

We are one of Ireland's top universities for graduate employability, with 96% of our graduates working or in further study within six months of graduating. Galway is one of five global hubs for biomedicine, with 8 of the top 10 global medtech firms based in Galway. The city is also an ICT hotspot, with Ireland being home to 8 of the top 10 global ICT companies. The multinationals in Galway include Medtronic, Boston Scientific, Merit Medical, SAP, Hewlett Packard, Cisco Systems, Avaya and EA Games. Galway's Atlantic coast is also the perfect location for marine and energy research..

## GRADUATE PERMIT SCHEME
