STATUTE LI.

WE, the Governing Body of University College, Galway, under and by virtue of the powers in that behalf conferred on us by the above Acts, DO by this present instrument under the Seal of University College, Galway, make the Statute contained in the Schedule hereof for the general government of the said College.

SCHEDULE — STATUTE LI.

All previous Statutes of University College, Galway, shall be read and construed with the alterations, additions and modifications hereinafter set forth.

CHAPTER I

INCREASE OF PENSION OF RETIRED PENSIONABLE STATUTORY STAFF

1. A new notional pension (hereinafter called 'the new pension') shall be computed in the case of each retired pensionable Professor and each retired pensionable Lecturer of the College.
2. For the purpose of computing the new pension the stipend forming the basis of the calculation shall be deemed to be the retiring salary at present payable after the same service in the Professorship or Lectureship held by such retired Professor or Lecturer before his retirement. In all other respects the new pension shall be computed in accordance with the Statutes of the College and the terms of the Pension Scheme.
3. The amount by which the new pension (computed as aforesaid) exceeds the amount of an existing pension payable by the College to each such retired Professor or Lecturer shall be called 'new additional pension' and shall be payable out of the general income of the College as from the First day of July, 1961, subject however to the two limitations as to the amount thereof hereinafter provided.
4. (a) Whenever and so often as the retiring salary attached to a pensionable Professorship, Lectureship, or Office (or Professorship and Office combined) shall be hereafter increased any former holder

of the same or the comparable Professorship, Lectureship, or Office (or Professorship and Office combined) shall be entitled to have his pension calculated and paid (as from the date of such increase of retiring salary) as if his retiring salary had at the date of his retirement been the same amount as the retiring salary payable after such increase.

(b) Any additional pension hereafter payable by virtue of this section shall be called 'new additional pension' and shall be paid out of the general income of the College subject to the two limitations as to the amount thereof hereinafter provided.

5. New additional pension payable by virtue of this Statute shall be subject to the two following limitations as to the amount thereof:—

- (i) The total sum payable in respect of an existing College pension and new additional pension shall not exceed two-thirds of the current maximum retiring salary appropriate to the case of the particular Professor, Lecturer or Officer.
- (ii) A new additional pension shall in no case exceed one-third of an existing College Pension.

6. The Bursar shall maintain and keep a Table or Record which shall contain particulars of the amount of any new additional pension payable by virtue of this Statute, the name, period of service, and former office of the Pensioner and the new retiring salary from which the new additional pension is computed.

7. It shall be a condition precedent to the payment of new additional pension that evidence of being alive satisfactory to the Governing Body shall be furnished by the person entitled.

CHAPTER II

INTERMISSION OF LECTURES. SABBATICAL YEAR

1. The Governing Body may, if it thinks fit, give leave of absence for the purpose of special study for the duration of one College Session to a Professor, Lecturer or Assistant (such Professor, Lecturer, or Assistant, being of not less than seven years standing) on such conditions as the Governing Body shall determine.

2. Chapter XVII of Statute XVII of University College, Galway, is hereby revoked.

CHAPTER III

1. Nothing herein contained shall affect any appointment made, right acquired, liability incurred or act done during any previous Statute of the College.

2. This Statute shall come into operation on the Fourteenth day of February, 1962 and may be cited as Statute LI, University College, Galway, or Stat. LI. Univ. Coll. Galway.
