STATUTE LVII

WE, the Governing Body of University College, Galway, under and by virtue of the powers in that behalf conferred on us by the above Acts DO by this present instrument under the Seal of University College, Galway, make the Statute contained in the Schedule hereto for the general government of the said College.

SCHEDULE—STATUTE LVII

All previous Statutes of University College, Galway, shall be read and construed with the alterations, additions and modifications hereinafter set forth.

CHAPTER I

STIPENDS AND ALLOWANCES ATTACHED TO STATUTORY OFFICES, PROFESSORSHIPS AND LECTURESHIPS

1. Notwithstanding anything contained in any previous Statute of the College the stipends and allowances attached to the Offices, Professorships and Lectureships referred to in Table "A" and in Table "B" to this Chapter shall, on and from the first day of October, 1963, be the stipends and allowances set forth in the said Tables.

TABLE A

1. The annual stipend of the President shall as from 1st October, 1963 be £3,660 and shall as from 1st February, 1964, be £4,100. In addition, he shall be entitled to residence, fuel and light as heretofore and to a non-pensionable allowance of £575 per annum as from 1st October, 1963 and of £645 per annum as from 1st February, 1964, in respect of the expenses of his Office.

2. The annual stipend (including pensionable allowance in respect of house, fire and light) of the Registrar and Secretary shall as from 1st October, 1963, be £1,330 and shall as from 1st February, 1964 be £1,490;
3. The annual stipend of the Bursar shall as from 1st October, 1963, be £660 and shall as from 1st February, 1964, be £740.
4. The annual stipend of the holder of each of the following full-time Professorships, namely:—
  - (a) Professorship of Modern Irish;
  - (b) Professorship of Old and Middle Irish and Celtic Philology;
  - (c) Professorship of Ancient Classics;
  - (d) Professorship of Mathematics;
  - (e) Professorship of Experimental Physics;
  - (f) Professorship of English Language and English Literature;
  - (g) Professorship of Chemistry;
  - (h) Professorship of Botany;
  - (i) Professorship of Zoology;
  - (j) Professorship of Civil Engineering;
  - (k) Professorship of Anatomy;
  - (l) Professorship of Physiology;
  - (m) Professorship of Mathematical Physics;
  - (n) Professorship of Geology including Physical Geography and Mineralogy;
  - (o) Professorship of Romance Languages;
  - (p) Professorship of German;
  - (q) Professorship of Philosophy;
  - (r) Professorship of History;
  - (s) Professorship of Economics, Commerce and Accountancy;
  - (t) Professorship of Education;
  - (u) Professorship of Celtic Archaeology;
  - (v) Professorship of Experimental Medicine and Practical Pharmacology;
  - (w) Professorship of Biochemistry,

shall as from 1st October, 1963 be £2,350 on appointment increasing to a maximum of £2,850 by annual increments of £50 for each completed year of service since appointment and

shall as from 1st February, 1964 <sup>to</sup> £2,600 on appointment increasing to a maximum of £3,200 by annual increments of £60 for each completed year of service since appointment subject to the provisions where applicable of Chapter II of Statute LIV of University College, Galway.

5. The annual stipend of the Associate Professorship of Ancient Classics shall be £2,800. The annual stipend shall be non-incremental.
6. The annual stipend of the holder of each of the following full-time Lectureships namely :—
  - (a) Lectureship in Mathematics ;
  - (b) Lectureship in Education (through Irish) ;
  - (c) Lectureship in History (through Irish) ;
  - (d) Lectureship in Ancient Classics ;
  - (e) Lectureship in Economics, Commerce and Accountancy (through Irish) ;
  - (f) Lectureship in Civil Engineering ;
  - (g) Lectureship in Botany ;
  - (h) Lectureship in Experimental Physics ;
  - (i) Lectureship in Mathematical Physics ;
  - (j) Lectureship in Chemistry ;
  - (k) Lectureship in Romance Languages ;
  - (l) Lectureship in Celtic Languages ;
  - (m) Lectureship in Philosophy ;
  - (n) Lectureship in Anatomy ;
  - (o) Lectureship in Physiology ;
  - (p) Lectureship (No. 2) in Mathematics ;
  - (q) Lectureship in English Language & English Literature ;
  - (r) Lectureship (No. 2) in Civil Engineering ;
  - (s) Lectureship in Physical Chemistry ;
  - (t) Lectureship (No. 2) in Experimental Physics ;
  - (u) Lectureship (No. 2) in Mathematical Physics ;
  - (v) Lectureship in History (with special reference to Medieval History) ;
  - (w) Lectureship in Geography ;

shall as from 1st October, 1963 be £1,500 on appointment increasing to a maximum of £2,200 by annual increments of £70 for each completed year of service since appointment and shall as from 1st February, 1964 be £1,700 on appointment increasing to a maximum of £2,400 by annual increments of £70 for each completed year of service since appointment subject to the provisions where applicable of Chapter II of Statute LIV of University College, Galway.

7. The stipends of the holders of the foregoing Professorships and Lectureships where such are to be increased by annual increments shall be calculated in accordance with Sections 4 and 6 hereof and the increased stipends so calculated or otherwise hereby fixed shall be payable on or after the first day of October, 1963.

1. The annual stipend of the Professorships and Lectureships set out in this Table shall, as from 1st October, 1963, be the sum set opposite the respective Titles of the said Professorships and Lectureships as follows:—

(2) Lectureship in Pathology and Lectureship in Bacteriology, £730 each on appointment increasing to a maximum of £930 by annual increments of £20 for each completed year of service since appointment.

*Provided* that in respect of the Professorship of Therapeutics, Pharmacology and Materia Medica, Statute XXIX of University College, Galway in its application to the holder of the said Professorship in the contingency provided for by the said Statute shall be read as if the figures and words "£550 per annum" were substituted for the figures "£188 per annum with £12 additional per annum so long as the additional income of the College shall continue" wherever these latter figures and words appear in the said Statute.

*Provided* also that in respect of the Professorship of Surgery, the Professorship of Medicine, and the Professorship of Midwifery and Gynaecology, Statute XXIX of University College, Galway,

in its application to the holder of any of the said three Professorships in the contingency provided for by the said Statute shall be read as if the figures and words "£850 per annum" were substituted for the figures and words "£188 per annum with £12 additional per annum so long as the additional income of the College shall continue" wherever these latter figures and words appear in the said Statute.

*Provided* further that Statute XLI of University College, Galway in its application to the holder of the Professorship of Pathology or the holder of the Professorship of Bacteriology in the contingency provided for by Section 2 of Chapter I or section 2 of Chapter II of the said Statute shall be read as if the figures and words "£850 per annum" were substituted for the figures and words "£450 per annum" where the latter figures and words appear in the said sections.

## CHAPTER II — PENSIONS

1. Notwithstanding anything contained in any previous Statute of the College the pension payable to the following :—

- (a) each full-time Statutory Officer ;
- (b) each full-time Professor ;
- (c) each full-time Lecturer ;
- (d) each of the following part-time Professors, namely :—  
Professor of Pathology, Professor of Bacteriology,  
Professor of Surgery, Professor of Medicine, Professor  
of Midwifery and Gynaecology ;
- (e) each of the following part-time Lecturers, namely :—  
Lecturer in Pathology, Lecturer in Bacteriology ;

shall be calculated in accordance with the relevant provisions of existing Statutes of the College on the annual stipend payable at the date of retirement to such Officer, Professor or Lecturer pursuant to the provisions of Chapter I of this Statute.

*Provided* that for the purpose of calculating the pension payable on the retirement of the President, the present holder of the Professorship of Geology including Physical Geography, and Mineralogy, the present holder of the Professorship of Education, and the Lady Superintendent the annual stipend payable at date of retirement shall be deemed to be :—

- (a) in the case of the President £4,635 ;
- (b) in the case of the present holder of the Professorship of Geology including Physical Geography and Mineralogy, £4,690 ;
- (c) in the case of the present holder of the Professorship of Education, £3,940 ;
- (d) in the case of the Lady Superintendent, £930.

2. In addition to the sum now being paid annually into the Pension Fund there shall henceforth be paid and transferred to the Pension Fund out of the annual income granted by the Oireachtas for the general purposes of the College or out of any other moneys of the College applicable thereto an additional annual sum of £3,815.

3. On coming into operation of this Statute, former holders of Pensionable Professorships, Pensionable Lectureships or Pensionable Offices shall be entitled to have their current pensions calculated and paid in the manner and subject to the conditions prescribed by Statute LI of University College, Galway.

### CHAPTER III — GRATUITIES

1. Notwithstanding anything contained in any previous Statute of the College the annual stipend for the purpose of calculating in accordance with the relevant provisions of existing Statutes of the College, the amount of the gratuity payable on death or retirement of :—

- (a) each full-time Statutory Officer ;
- (b) each full-time Professor ;
- (c) each full-time Lecturer ;
- (d) each of the following part-time Professors namely :—  
Professor of Pathology, Professor of Bacteriology,  
Professor of Surgery, Professor of Medicine, Professor  
of Midwifery and Gynaecology ;
- (e) each of the following part-time Lecturers, namely :—  
Lecturer in Pathology, Lecturer in Bacteriology ;

shall in every case, save as in hereinafter provided, be the stipend payable at the date of death or retirement pursuant to the provisions of Chapter I of this Statute.

*Provided* that the annual stipend payable at date of death or retirement shall be deemed to be :—

- (a) in the case of the President, £4,635 ;
- (b) in the case of the present holder of the Professorship of Geology including Physical Geography and Mineralogy, £4,690 ;
- (c) in the case of the present holder of the Professorship of Education, £3,940.
- (d) in the case of the Lady Superintendent, £930.

## CHAPTER IV

1. For the purpose of this Statute
  - (i) the full-time Statutory Officers of the College are the President and the Lady Superintendent ;
  - (ii) the full-time Professors of the College are the holders of the Professorships set forth in Section 4 of Table "A" to Chapter I of this Statute ;
  - (iii) the full-time Lecturers of the College are the holders of the Lectureships set forth in Section 5 of Table "A" to Chapter I of this Statute.
2. Nothing herein contained shall affect any appointment made, right acquired, liability incurred or act done under any previous Statute of the College.

## CHAPTER V

1. This Statute shall come into operation on the Eleventh day of June, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-four and may be cited as Statute LVII of University College, Galway or Stat. LVII Univ. Coll., Galway.
