STATUTE LXIV

WE, the Governing Body of University College, Galway, under and by virtue of the powers in that behalf conferred on us by the above Acts DO by this present instrument under the Seal of University College, Galway, make the Statute contained in the Schedule hereto for the general government of the said College.

SCHEDULE—STATUTE LXIV

All previous Statutes of University College, Galway, shall be read and construed with the alterations, additions and modifications hereinafter set forth.

CHAPTER I

STIPENDS AND ALLOWANCES ATTACHED TO STATUTORY
OFFICES, PROFESSORSHIPS AND LECTURESHIPS

1. Notwithstanding anything contained in any previous Statute of the College the stipends and allowances attached to the Offices, Professorships and Lectureships referred to in Table "A" and in Table "B" to this Chapter shall, on and from the 1st day of April, 1966, be the stipends and allowances set forth in the said Tables.
2. This chapter shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 31st day of March, 1966.

TABLE A

1. The annual stipend of the President shall be £4,715. In addition he shall be entitled to residence, fuel and light as heretofore and to a non-pensionable allowance of £742 per annum as from 1st April, 1966, in respect of the expenses of his Office.
2. The annual stipend (including pensionable allowance in respect of house, fire and light) of the Registrar and Secretary shall be £1,715.
3. The annual stipend of the Bursar shall be £2,990 on appointment increasing to a maximum of £3,680 by annual increments of £69 for each completed year of service since appointment.

4. The annual stipend of the Librarian shall be £1,955 on appointment increasing to a maximum of £2,760 by annual increments of £80 10s. 0d. for each completed year of service since appointment.

5. The annual stipend of the holder of each of the following full-time Professorships, namely :—

- (1) Professorship of Modern Irish ;
- (2) Professorship of Old and Middle Irish and Celtic Philology ;
- (3) Professorship of Ancient Classics ;
- (4) Professorship of Mathematics ;
- (5) Professorship of Experimental Physics ;
- (6) Professorship of Old and Medieval English ;
- (7) Professorship of Modern English ;
- (8) Professorship of Chemistry ;
- (9) Professorship of Botany ;
- (10) Professorship of Zoology ;
- (11) Professorship of Civil Engineering ;
- (12) Professorship of Anatomy ;
- (13) Professorship of Physiology ;
- (14) Professorship of Mathematical Physics ;
- (15) Professorship of Geology including Physical Geography and Mineralogy ;
- (16) Professorship of Romance Languages ;
- (17) Professorship of German ;
- (18) Professorship of Philosophy ;
- (19) Professorship of History ;
- (20) Professorship of Economics, Commerce and Accountancy ;
- (21) Professorship of Education ;
- (22) Professorship of Celtic Archaeology ;
- (23) Professorship of Experimental Medicine and Practical Pharmacology ;
- (24) Professorship of Biochemistry ;
- (25) Professorship of Inorganic Chemistry ;
- (26) Professorship of Electron Physics ;

shall be £2,990 on appointment increasing to a maximum of £3,680 by annual increments of £69 for each completed year of service since appointment subject to the provisions where applicable of Chapter II of Statute LIV of University College, Galway.

6. The annual stipends of the Associate Professorships of Ancient Classics and of History shall each be £3,220. The said annual stipends shall be non-incremental.

7. The annual stipend of the holder of each of the following full-time Lectureships, namely :—

- (1) Lectureship (No. 1) in Mathematics ;
- (2) Lectureship (No. 2) in Mathematics ;
- (3) Lectureship in Education ;
- (4) Lectureship in History (through Irish) ;
- (5) Lectureship in History (with special reference to Medieval History) ;
- (6) Lectureship (No. 1) in Ancient Classics ;

- (7) Lectureship (No. 2) in Ancient Classics ;
- (8) Lectureship in Economics, Commerce and Accountancy (through Irish) ;
- (9) Lectureship (No. 1) in Civil Engineering ;
- (10) Lectureship (No. 2) in Civil Engineering ;
- (11) Lectureship (No. 3) in Civil Engineering ;
- (12) Lectureship in Botany ;
- (13) Lectureship (No. 1) in Experimental Physics ;
- (14) Lectureship (No. 2) in Experimental Physics ;
- (15) Lectureship (No. 1) in Mathematical Physics ;
- (16) Lectureship (No. 2) in Mathematical Physics ;
- (17) Lectureship (No. 1) in Chemistry ;
- (18) Lectureship (No. 2) in Chemistry ;
- (19) Lectureship in Biochemistry ;
- (20) Lectureship in Physical Chemistry ;
- (21) Lectureship in Romance Languages ;
- (22) Lectureship in French ;
- (23) Lectureship in Celtic Languages ;
- (24) Lectureship in Modern Irish ;
- (25) Lectureship in Philosophy ;
- (26) Lectureship in Anatomy ;
- (27) Lectureship (No. 1) in Physiology ;
- (28) Lectureship (No. 2) in Physiology ;
- (29) Lectureship in English Language and English Literature ;
- (30) Lectureship in Geography ;
- (31) Lectureship in Applied Economics ;
- (32) Lectureship in Microbiology ;
- (33) Lectureship in Zoology

shall be £1,955 on appointment increasing to a maximum of £2,760 by annual increments of £80 10s. 0d. for each completed year of service since appointment subject to the provisions where applicable of Chapter II of Statute LIV of University College, Galway.

8. The stipends of the holders of the foregoing Professorships and Lectureships where such are to be increased by annual increments shall be calculated in accordance with Sections 4 and 6 hereof and the increased stipends so calculated or otherwise hereby fixed shall be payable after the first day of April 1966.

1. The annual stipend of the Professorships and Lectureships set out in this Table shall, as from 1st April, 1966, be the sum set opposite the respective Titles of the said Professorships and Lectureships as follows :—

- (2) Lectureship in Pathology and Lectureship in Bacteriology, £840 each on appointment increasing to a maximum of £1,070 by annual increments of £23 for each completed year of service since appointment.

PROVIDED that in respect of the Professorship of Therapeutics, Pharmacology and Materia Medica, the Professorship of Surgery, the Professorship of Medicine, and the Professorship of Midwifery and Gynaecology, Statute XXIX of University College, Galway in its application to the holder of any of the said four Professorships in the contingency provided for by the said Statute shall be read as if the figures and words "£1,090 per annum" were substituted for the figures and words "£188 per annum with £12 additional per annum so long as the additional income of the College shall continue" wherever these latter figures and words appear in the said Statute

PROVIDED further that Statute XLI of University College, Galway in its application to the holder of the Professorship of Pathology and the holder of the Professorship of Bacteriology in the contingency provided for by Section 2 of Chapter 1 or Section 2 of Chapter II shall be read as if the figures and words "£1,090 per annum" were substituted for the figures and words "£450 per annum" where the latter figures and words appear in the said sections.

CHAPTER II—PENSIONS

1. Notwithstanding anything contained in any previous Statute of the College the pension payable to the following :—
- (a) each full-time Statutory Officer ;
 - (b) each full-time Professor ;
 - (c) each full-time Lecturer ;
 - (d) each of the following part-time Professors, namely,
Professor of Pathology, Professor of Bacteriology,
Professor of Surgery, Professor of Medicine,
Professor of Midwifery and Gynaecology ;
 - (e) each of the following part-time Lecturers, namely :—
Lecturer in Pathology, Lecturer in Bacteriology

shall be calculated in accordance with the relevant provisions of existing Statutes of the College on the annual stipend payable at the date of retirement to such Officer, Professor or Lecturer pursuant to the provisions of Chapter I of this Statute.

PROVIDED that for the purposes of calculating the pension payable on the retirement of the President, the present holder of

the Professorship of Geology including Physical Geography, and Mineralogy, the present holder of the Professorship of Education, and the Lady Superintendent the annual stipend payable at date of retirement shall be deemed to be :—

- (a) in the case of the President, £5,330 ;
 - (b) in the case of the present holder of the Professorship of Geology including Physical Geography and Mineralogy, £5,395 ;
 - (c) in the case of the present holder of the Professorship of Education, £4,531 ;
 - (d) in the case of the Lady Superintendent, £1,184.
2. Instead of the sum now being paid annually into the Statutory Pensionable Officers Pension Fund there shall henceforth be paid and transferred to the said Fund out of the annual income granted by the Oireachtas for the general purposes of the College or out of any other moneys of the College applicable thereto an annual sum of £30,000.
3. On coming into operation of this Statute, former holders of Pensionable Professorships, Pensionable Lectureships, or Pensionable Offices, shall be entitled to have their current pension calculated and paid in the manner and subject to the conditions prescribed by Statute LI of University College, Galway.

CHAPTER III—GRATUITIES

1. Notwithstanding anything contained in any previous Statute of the College the annual stipend for the purposes of calculating in accordance with the relevant provisions of existing Statutes of the College the amount of the gratuity payable on death or retirement of :—

- (a) each full-time Statutory Officer ;
- (b) each full-time Professor ;
- (c) each full-time Lecturer ;
- (d) each of the following part-time Professors namely :—
Professor of Pathology, Professor of Bacteriology,
Professor of Surgery, Professor of Medicine,
Professor of Midwifery and Gynaecology ;
- (e) each of the following part-time Lecturers, namely :—
Lecturer in Pathology, Lecturer in Bacteriology ;

shall in every case, save as in hereafter provided, be the stipend payable at the date of death or retirement pursuant to the provisions of Chapter I of this Statute.

PROVIDED that the annual stipend payable at date of death or retirement shall be deemed to be :—

- (a) in the case of the President, £5,330 ;
- (b) in the case of the present holder of the Professorship of Geology including Physical Geography and Mineralogy, £5,395 ;
- (c) in the case of the present holder of the Professorship of Education, £4,531 ;
- (d) in the case of the Lady Superintendent, £1,184.

CHAPTER IV

THE WIDOWS OF STATUTORY PENSIONABLE OFFICERS
PENSION FUND.

1. In addition to the sum (£800) now being paid annually into the Statutory Pensionable Officers Pension Fund the Governing Body shall henceforth pay into the Pension Fund an additional annual sum of £400 until the Governing Body shall otherwise determine.

CHAPTER V

CHILDREN'S ALLOWANCES

1. Chapter I of Statute LV of University College, Galway, is hereby amended as follows:—
 - (a) By the substitution in Section 2 of the figure "£46" for the figure "£40" mentioned therein;
 - (b) By the substitution in Section 3 of the figure "£23" for the figure "£20" mentioned therein;
 - (c) By the substitution in Section 4 of the figure "£17 5s. 0d." for the figure "£15" mentioned therein.
2. This Chapter shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 31st March, 1966, and the increased allowances set out in Section 1 thereof shall be payable on and from 1st day of April, 1966.

CHAPTER VI

1. For the purpose of this Statute:
 - (i) the full-time Statutory Officers of the College are the President, the Lady Superintendent, the Librarian, and the Bursar;
 - (ii) the full-time Professors of the College are the holders of the Professorships set forth in Section 4 of Table "A" to Chapter I of this Statute;
 - (iii) the full-time Lecturers of the College are the holders of the Lectureships set forth in Section 5 of Table "A" to Chapter I of this Statute.
2. Nothing herein contained shall affect any appointment made, right acquired, liability incurred or act done under any previous Statute of the College.

CHAPTER VII

1. This Statute shall come into operation on the Fifteenth day of June, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty Six and may be cited as Statute LXIV of University College, Galway or Stat. LXIV Univ. Coll. Galway.
