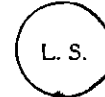


IRISH UNIVERSITIES ACT, 1908  
ACHT CHOLAISTE PHRIOMH-SCOILE NA GAILLIMHE, 1929.  
UNIVERSITY COLLEGE, GALWAY.  
STATUTE LXVII.

WE, the Governing Body of University College, Galway, under and by virtue of the powers in that behalf conferred on us by the above Acts DO by this present instrument under the Seal of University College, Galway, make the Statute contained in the Schedule hereto for the general government of the said College.

SCHEDULE—STATUTE LXVII

All previous Statutes of University College, Galway, shall be read and construed with the alterations, additions and modifications hereinafter set forth.

CHAPTER I

1. The Lectureship in History (through Irish) established by Chapter XIII of Statute XVII of University College, Galway, is hereby extinguished, and in lieu thereof there shall be established in the College in the event of its institution by the Senate of the National University of Ireland a full-time Lectureship as follows :—Lectureship in History.

The holder of the foregoing Lectureship shall carry out the duties of the Lectureship under the direction of the Professor of History and of the Associate Professor of History (through Irish).

2. There shall be established in the College in the event of their institution by the Senate of the National University of Ireland the following full-time Lectureships :—
  - (a) Lectureship (Number 2) in Modern Irish. The holder shall carry out the duties of the Lectureship under the direction of the Professor of Modern Irish.
  - (b) Lectureship in Italian. The holder shall carry out the duties of the Lectureship under the direction of the Professor of Romance Languages.
  - (c) Lectureship in Geology. The holder shall carry out the duties of the Lectureship under the direction of the Professor of Geology.
  - (d) Lectureship in Statistics. The holder shall carry out the duties of the Lectureship under the direction of the Professor of Mathematics.

3. The annual stipend of the holder of each of the foregoing full-time Lectureships shall be £1,955 on appointment increasing to a maximum of £2,760 by annual increments of £80 10s. 0d. for each completed year of service since appointment. The Governing Body may in its discretion in accordance with Chapter II of Statute LIV of University College, Galway, if the President (having regard to the qualifications and College service if any of the persons appointed) so recommends fix the commencing stipend of the Lectureship at any point in the incremental salary scale applicable thereto.
4. (a) The foregoing five Lectureships shall be pensionable offices within the meaning of Chapter XXV of Statute XVII of University College, Galway and the amendments thereto and shall be annexed to the appropriate Table of the Pension Scheme. The holder of each Lectureship shall be entitled to payment of both Pension and Gratuity under and in accordance with the provisions of Chapter II and Chapter III of Statute XXXVI of University College, Galway, and of the Statutes of the College.
- (b) The annual stipend for the purpose of calculating Pension and Gratuity in accordance with the relevant provisions of existing Statutes of the College shall be that payable at date of retirement or death of the holder pursuant to the provisions of Section 2 of this Chapter.
- (c) There shall be paid into the Pension Fund such additional sum as an Actuary shall certify to be necessary for providing such Pension and Gratuity as aforesaid.

#### CHAPTER II

1. There shall be established in the College in the event of their institution by the Senate of the National University of Ireland the following part-time Professorship and part-time Lectureship :—
  - (i) A part-time Professorship of Paediatrics.
  - (ii) A part-time Lectureship in Obstetrics and Gynaecology.  
The holder of this part-time Lectureship shall carry out the duties of the Lectureship under the direction of the Professor of Obstetrics and Gynaecology.
2. The annual stipend of the holder of the foregoing part-time Professorship of Paediatrics shall be £1,840.  
The annual stipend of the holder of the foregoing part-time Lectureship in Obstetrics and Gynaecology shall be £800.
3. (a) The Professorship of Paediatrics shall be a pensionable office within the meaning of Chapter XXV of Statute XVII of University College, Galway, and the amendments thereto and shall be annexed to the appropriate Table of the Pension Scheme. The holder of the Professorship shall be entitled to payment of both Pension and Gratuity under and in accordance with the provisions of Chapter II and Chapter III of Statute XXXVI of University College, Galway, and of the Statutes of the College.
- (b) The annual stipend for the purpose of calculating Pension and Gratuity in accordance with the relevant provisions of

existing Statutes of the College shall be that payable at date of retirement or death of the holder.

- (c) There shall be paid into the Pension Fund such additional sum as an Actuary shall certify to be necessary for providing such Pension and Gratuity as aforesaid.
4. The holder of the foregoing Professorship of Paediatrics and the holder of the foregoing part-time Lectureship in Obstetrics and Gynaecology shall (in addition to such other duties as may be prescribed) give clinical instruction to the medical students of the College at such hours and in such hospitals as the Academic Council may prescribe subject to review by the Governing Body.

#### CHAPTER III

1. The holder of the foregoing part-time Professorship of Paediatrics shall, subject to good conduct and the due fulfilment of his duties, continue in office until he shall have attained the age of sixty-five years, and may thereafter be continued by the Senate in Office for five further years provided that this further continuance in Office is recommended to the Senate of the University by the Governing Body, with the approval of the President, and is sanctioned by the Senate annually.
2. The holder of each of the foregoing five full-time Lectureships and of the foregoing part-time Lectureship in Obstetrics and Gynaecology shall subject to good conduct and to the due fulfilment of his duties hold office for seven years after which he shall be eligible for re-appointment. If re-appointed he shall subject to good conduct and the due fulfilment of his duties hold office until he shall have attained the age of sixty-five years and may thereafter be continued in office for five further years : Provided that such further continuance in office is recommended to the Senate of the University by the Governing Body with the approval of the President and is sanctioned annually by the said Senate.
3. The holder of each of the foregoing five full-time Lectureships and of the foregoing part-time Professorship of Paediatrics and of the foregoing part-time Lectureship in Obstetrics and Gynaecology shall be entitled to the annual allowances in respect of a wife and children payable in pursuance to Statute XXXVII and Statute LV of University College, Galway.

#### CHAPTER IV

1. Nothing herein contained shall affect any appointment made, right acquired or act done under any previous Statute of the College.
2. This Statute shall come into operation on the Twenty-eighth day of February, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-seven and may be cited as Statute LXVII University College, Galway, or Stat. LXVII, Univ. Coll. Galway.
