**STATUTE LXXIII**

WE, the Governing Body of University College, Galway, under and by virtue of the powers in that behalf conferred on us by the above Acts, DO by this present instrument under the seal of University College, Galway, make the Statute contained in the Schedule hereto for the general government of the said College.

SCHEDULE—STATUTE LXXIII.

All previous Statutes of University College, Galway shall be read and construed with the alterations, additions and modifications hereinafter set forth.

CHAPTER I

NEW PROFESSORSHIPS AND LECTURESHIPS

1. There shall be established in the College in the event of their institution by the Senate of the National University of Ireland the following posts :—

Professorship of Oceanography  
Lectureship (No. 3) in Ancient Classics  
Lectureship in General European Pre-History  
Lectureship in Mediaeval English Literature  
Lectureship (No. 2) in French  
Lectureship (No. 2) in Geography  
Lectureship (No. 4) in Modern Irish  
Lectureship (No. 4) in Mathematics  
Lectureship (No. 3) in Biochemistry  
Lectureship (No. 2) in Microbiology  
Lectureship (No. 4) in Experimental Physics  
Lectureship (No. 3) in Zoology  
Lectureship (No. 4) in Chemistry  
Lectureship (No. 4) in Mathematical Physics  
Lectureship (No. 3) in Botany  
Lectureship (No. 2) in Geology

- Lectureship (No. 4) in Biochemistry
- Lectureship (No. 3) in Microbiology
- Lectureship in Pharmacology
- Lectureship in Bacteriology and Virology
- Lectureship (No. 2) in Anatomy
- Lectureship in Surgical Science
- Lectureship in General and Applied Physiology
- Lectureship in Surgery (Chest Surgery) (Part-time)
- Lectureship in Surgery (Orthopaedic) (Part-time)
- Lectureship in Engineering (Public Health) (Part-time)

2. The annual stipend of the holder of the Professorship of Oceanography shall be £2,990 on appointment increasing to a maximum of £3,680 by annual increments of £69 for each completed year of service since appointment. The Governing Body may in its discretion in accordance with Statute IV of University College Galway, and if the President (or any person appointed) so recommends fix the commencing stipend of the Professorship at any point in the incremental salary scale applicable thereto.
3. The holder of the Professorship shall, subject to good conduct and the due fulfilment of his duties, continue in office if he shall have attained the age of sixty-five years, and may thereafter be continued in office for five further years PROVIDED that such further continuance in office is recommended to the Senate of the National University of Ireland by the Governing Body with the approval of the President and is sanctioned annually by the said Senate.
4. (a) The Professorship of Oceanography shall be a pensionable office within the meaning of Chapter XXV of Statute XVII of University College, Galway, and the amount payable thereto and shall be annexed to the appropriate Table of the Pension Scheme. The holder of the Professorship shall be entitled to payment of both Pension and Gratuity in accordance with the provisions of Chapter II and Chapter III of Statute XXXVI of University College Galway, and of the Statutes of the College.
  - (b) The annual stipend for the purpose of calculating Pension and Gratuity in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Statutes of the College shall be deemed to be the amount payable at date of retirement or death of the holder pursuant to the provisions of Section 2 of this Chapter.
  - (c) There shall be paid into the Pension Fund such additional sum as an Actuary shall certify to be necessary for providing such Pension and Gratuity as aforesaid.
5. The holder of the Professorship of Oceanography shall be entitled to the annual allowances in respect of a wife and children pursuant to Statute XXXVII and Statute I of University College, Galway.

## CHAPTER II

1. The Holders of the following full-time Lectureships shall carry out the duties of the Lectureships as follows :—
  - (a) Lectureship (No. 3) in Ancient Classics—under the direction of the Professor of Ancient Classics.
  - (b) Lectureship in General European Pre-History—under the direction of the Professor of Celtic Archaeology.
  - (c) Lectureship in Mediaeval English Literature—under the direction of the Professor of Old and Mediaeval English.
  - (d) Lectureship (No. 2) in French—under the direction of the Professor of Romance Languages.
  - (e) Lectureship (No. 2) in Geography—under the direction of the Professor of Geography.
  - (f) Lectureship (No. 4) in Modern Irish—under the direction of the Professor of Modern Irish.
  - (g) Lectureship (No. 4) in Mathematics—under the direction of the Professor of Mathematics.
  - (h) Lectureship (No. 3) in Biochemistry—under the direction of the Professor of Biochemistry.
  - (i) Lectureship (No. 2) in Microbiology—under the direction of the Professor of Bacteriology.
  - (j) Lectureship (No. 4) in Experimental Physics—under the direction of the Professor of Experimental Physics.
  - (k) Lectureship (No. 3) in Zoology—under the direction of the Professor of Zoology.
  - (l) Lectureship (No. 4) in Chemistry—under the direction of the Professor of Chemistry.
  - (m) Lectureship (No. 4) in Mathematical Physics—under the direction of the Professor of Mathematical Physics.
  - (n) Lectureship (No. 3) in Botany—under the direction of the Professor of Botany.
  - (o) Lectureship (No. 2) in Geology—under the direction of the Professor of Geology.
  - (p) Lectureship (No. 4) in Biochemistry—under the direction of the Professor of Biochemistry.
  - (q) Lectureship (No. 3) in Microbiology—under the direction of the Professor of Bacteriology.
  - (r) Lectureship in Pharmacology—under the direction of the Professor of Pharmacology.
  - (s) Lectureship in Bacteriology and Virology—under the direction of the Professor of Bacteriology.
  - (t) Lectureship (No. 2) in Anatomy—under the direction of the Professor of Anatomy.
  - (u) Lectureship in Surgical Science—under the direction of the Professor of Surgery.
  - (v) Lectureship in General and Applied Physiology—under the direction of the Professor of Physiology.

2. The annual stipend of the holder of each of the foregoing twenty-two full-time Lectureships shall be £1,955 on appointment increasing to a maximum of £2,760 by annual increments of £80 10s. 0d. for each completed year of service since appointment. The Governing Body may in its discretion in accordance with Chapter II of Statute LIV of University College, Galway, if the President (having regard to the qualifications and College service if any of the person appointed) so recommends fix the commencing stipend of the Lectureship at any point in the incremental salary scale applicable thereto.
3. The holder of each of the foregoing twenty-two Lectureships shall subject to good conduct and to the due fulfilment of his duties hold office for seven years after which he shall be eligible for reappointment. If reappointed he shall subject to good conduct and the due fulfilment of his duties hold office until he shall have attained the age of sixty-five years and may thereafter be continued in office for five further years: PROVIDED that such further continuance in office is recommended to the Senate of the National University of Ireland by the Governing Body with the approval of the President and is sanctioned annually by the said Senate.
4. (a) The foregoing twenty-two Lectureships shall be pensionable offices within the meaning of Chapter XXV of Statute XVII of University College, Galway, and the amendments thereto and shall be annexed to the appropriate Table of the Pension Scheme. The holder of each Lectureship shall be entitled to payment of both Pension and Gratuity under and in accordance with the provisions of Chapter II and Chapter III of Statute XXVI of University College, Galway, and of the Statutes of the College.
  - (b) The annual stipend for the purpose of calculating Pension and Gratuity in accordance with the relevant provisions of existing Statutes of the College shall be that payable at date of retirement or death of the holder pursuant to the provisions of Section 2 of this Chapter.
  - (c) There shall be paid into the Pension Fund such additional sum as an actuary shall certify to be necessary for providing such Pension and Gratuity as aforesaid.
5. The holder of each of the foregoing twenty-two Lectureships shall be entitled to the annual allowances in respect of a wife and children pursuant to Statute XXXVII and Statute LV of University College, Galway.

#### CHAPTER III

1. The annual stipend of the following Part-time non-Pensionable Lectureships shall be the sum set opposite the respective Titles of the said Lectureships as follows:—
 

Lectureship in Surgery (Chest Surgery) ..	£800
Lectureship in Surgery (Orthopaedic) ..	£800
Lectureship in Engineering (Public Health)	£900

2. The Holders of the following part-time Lectureships shall carry out the duties of the Lectureships as follows :—
- Lectureship in Surgery (Chest Surgery)—under the direction of the Professor of Surgery.
- Lectureship in Surgery (Orthopaedic)—under the direction of the Professor of Surgery.
- Lectureship in Engineering (Public Health)—under the direction of the Professor of Engineering. The holder will co-operate also in providing courses under the direction of the Head of the Department in other areas of Civil Engineering.
3. The holder of each of the foregoing three Part-time Lectureships shall subject to good conduct and to the due fulfilment of his duties hold office for seven years after which he shall be eligible for reappointment. If reappointed he shall subject to good conduct and the due fulfilment of his duties hold office until he shall have attained the age of sixty-five years and may thereafter be continued in office for five further years : PROVIDED that such further continuance in office is recommended to the Senate of the National University of Ireland by the Governing Body with the approval of the President and is sanctioned annually by the said Senate.
4. The holder of each of the foregoing three Part-time Lectureships shall be entitled to the annual allowances in respect of children payable in pursuance to Statute LV of University College, Galway.
5. The holders of the following Lectureships—(i) Lectureship in Pharmacology, (ii) Lectureship in Bacteriology and Virology, (iii) Lectureship in Surgical Science, (iv) Lectureship in Surgery (Chest Surgery), (v) Lectureship in Surgery (Orthopaedic), shall be required to give clinical instruction to the Undergraduate and Postgraduate students of the College at such hours and in such hospitals as the Academic Council may prescribe subject to review by the Governing Body.

## CHAPTER IV

1. Nothing herein contained shall affect any appointment made right acquired or act done under any previous Statute of the College.
2. This Statute shall come into operation on the Twenty-ninth day of May, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Eight, and may be cited as Statute LXXIII University College, Galway, or Stat. LXXIII Univ. Coll., Galway.
