STATUTE LXXIX

WE, the Governing Body of University College, Galway, under and by virtue of the powers in that behalf conferred on us by above Acts, DO by this present instrument under the seal of University College, Galway, make the Statute contained in the Schedule hereto for the general government of the said College.

SCHEDULE—STATUTE LXXIX

All previous Statutes of University College, Galway, shall be read and construed with the alterations, additions and modifications hereinafter set forth.

CHAPTER I

1. The Professorship of Economics, Commerce, and Accounting is hereby extinguished.

CHAPTER II

*New Professorships and Lectureships*

1. There shall be established in the College in the event of their institution by the Senate of the National University of Ireland the following posts:—

Professorship of Economics

Professorship of Business Studies

 Professorship of Physical Chemistry (in the Department  
 of Chemistry)  
 Professorship of Microbiology  
 Professorship of Physics (with special reference to Quantum  
 and Theoretical Solid State Physics—in the Department  
 of Experimental Physics).

Lectureships (2) in Engineering—the particular speciality,  
 if any, in which the holder of each of these posts shall be  
 required to be particularly qualified, shall be specified  
 (on the recommendation of the Academic Council), by  
 simple resolution of the Governing Body before the post  
 is advertised.

2. The annual stipend of the holder of each of the following Pro-  
 fessorships shall be £3,260 on appointment increasing to a  
 maximum of £4,010 by annual increments of £75 for each  
 completed year of service since appointment :—

The Governing Body may in its discretion in accordance with Statute LIV of University College, Galway, and if the President (having regard to the qualifications and College service, if any, of the person appointed) so recommends fix the commencing stipend of the Professorship at any point in the incremental salary scale applicable thereto.

3. The annual stipend of the Associate Professorship of Mathematics shall be £3,510. The said annual stipend shall be non-incremental.

The holder of the Associate Professorship of Mathematics shall carry out his duties under the direction of the Professor of Mathematics.

4. The annual stipend of the holder of the Part-time Professorship of Psychiatry shall be £2,005.
5. The holder of each of the foregoing thirteen full-time Professorships, the holder of the Associate Professorship of Mathematics, and the holder of the Part-time Professorship of Psychiatry shall, subject to good conduct and the due fulfilment of his duties, continue in office until he shall have attained the age of sixty-five years; and may thereafter be continued in office for five further years; PROVIDED that such further continuance in office is recommended to the Senate of the National University of Ireland by the Governing Body with the approval of the President and is sanctioned annually by the said Senate.
6. (a) The foregoing thirteen full-time Professorships, the Associate Professorship of Mathematics, and the Part-time Professorship of Psychiatry shall be pensionable offices within the meaning of Chapter XXV of Statute XVII of University College, Galway, and the amendments thereto and shall be annexed to the appropriate Table of the Pension Scheme.

The holder of each Professorship and of the Associate Professorship shall be entitled to payment of both Pension and Gratuity in accordance with the provisions of Chapter II and Chapter III of Statute XXXVI of University College, Galway, and of the Statutes of the College.

- (b) The annual stipend for the purpose of calculating Pension and Gratuity in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Statutes of the College shall be deemed to be that payable at date of retirement or death of the holder pursuant to the provisions of Section 2, Section 3 and Section 4 of this Chapter.
  - (c) There shall be paid into the Pension Fund such additional sum as an Actuary shall certify to be necessary for providing such Pension and Gratuity as aforesaid.
7. The holder of each of the foregoing thirteen full-time Professorships, and the holder of the Associate Professorship, shall be entitled to the annual allowances in respect of a wife and children pursuant to Statute XXXVII, Statute LV and Statute LXXV of University College, Galway.
  8. The holder of the Part-time Professorship of Psychiatry shall be entitled to the annual allowances in respect of children payable in pursuant to Statute LV and Statute LXXV of University College, Galway.

#### CHAPTER III

1. The Holders of the following full-time Lectureships shall carry out the duties of the Lectureships as follows :—
  - (a) Lectureship (No. 3) in Education—under the direction of the Professor of Education.
  - (b) Lectureship in English Language—under the direction of the Professor of English.
  - (c) Lectureship (No. 2) in English—under the direction of the Professor of English.
  - (d) Lectureship (No. 4) in French—under the direction of the Professor of French.
  - (e) Lectureship (No. 2) in German—under the direction of the Professor of German.
  - (f) Lectureships (No. 3 and No. 4) in Geography—under the direction of the Professor of Geography.
  - (g) Lectureship (No. 3) in History—under the direction of the Professor of History.
  - (h) Lectureship (No. 2) in Philosophy—under the direction of the Professor of Philosophy.
  - (i) Lectureship (No. 1) in Political Science—under the direction of the Professor of Political Science and Sociology.
  - (j) Lectureship (No. 1) in Spanish—under the direction of the Associate Professor of Spanish.
  - (k) Lectureship (No. 1) in Economics—under the direction of the Professor of Economics.
  - (l) Lectureship in Business Studies—under the direction of the Professor of Business Studies.

- (m) Lectureships (No. 3 and No. 4 and No. 5) in Anatomy—under the direction of the Professor of Anatomy.
  - (n) Lectureship (No. 2) in Experimental Medicine (with special reference to animal behaviour)—under the direction of the Professor of Experimental Medicine.
  - (o) Lectureships (No. 4 and No. 5) in Physiology—under the direction of the Professor of Physiology.
  - (p) Lectureships (No. 5 and No. 6) in Engineering—under the direction of the Professor of Civil Engineering.
  - (q) Lectureship (No. 5) in Experimental Physics—under the direction of the Professor of Experimental Physics.
  - (r) Lectureship in Comparative Anatomy (in the Department of Anatomy)—under the direction of the Professor of Anatomy.
  - (s) Lectureships (No. 5 and No. 6) in Chemistry—under the direction of the Professor of Chemistry.
  - (t) Lectureship in Genetics (in the Department of Botany)—under the direction of the Professor of Botany.
  - (u) Lectureship (No. 5) in Mathematical Physics—under the direction of the Professor of Mathematical Physics.
  - (v) Lectureship (No. 5) in Biochemistry—under the direction of the Professor of Biochemistry.
  - (w) Lectureship (No. 5) in Mathematics—under the direction of the Professor of Mathematics.
  - (x) Lectureship (No. 4) in Zoology—under the direction of the Professor of Zoology.
2. The annual stipend of the holder of each of the foregoing thirty full-time Lectureships shall be £2,130 on appointment increasing to a maximum of £3,010 by annual increments of £88 for each completed year of service since appointment. The Governing Body may in its discretion in accordance with Chapter II of Statute LIV of University College, Galway, if the President (having regard to the qualifications and College service if any of the person appointed) so recommends fix the commencing stipend of the Lectureship at any point in the incremental salary scale applicable thereto.
  3. The holder of each of the foregoing thirty Lectureships shall subject to good conduct and to the due fulfilment of his duties hold office for seven years after which he shall be eligible for re-appointment. If reappointed he shall subject to good conduct and the due fulfilment of his duties hold office until he shall have attained the age of sixty-five years and may thereafter be continued in office for five further years: PROVIDED that such further continuance in office is recommended to the Senate of the National University of Ireland by the Governing Body with the approval of the President and is sanctioned annually by the said Senate.
  4. (a) The foregoing thirty Lectureships shall be pensionable offices within the meaning of Chapter XXV of Statute XVII of University College, Galway, and the amendments thereto and shall be annexed to the appropriate Table of the Pension Scheme. The holder of each Lectureship shall

be entitled to payment of both Pension and Gratuity under and in accordance with the provisions of Chapter II and Chapter III of Statute XXXVI of University College, Galway and the Statutes of the College.

- (b) The annual stipend for the purpose of calculating Pension and Gratuity in accordance with the relevant provisions of existing Statutes of the College shall be that payable at date of retirement or death of the holder pursuant to the provisions of Section 2 of this Chapter.
  - (c) There shall be paid into the Pension Fund such additional sum as an actuary shall certify to be necessary for providing such Pension and Gratuity, as aforesaid.
5. The holder of each of the foregoing thirty Lectureships shall be entitled to the annual allowances in respect of a wife and children pursuant to Statute XXXVII, Statute LV and Statute LXXV of University College, Galway.

#### CHAPTER IV

1. The annual stipend of the following Part-time non-Pensionable Lectureships shall be the sum set opposite the respective Titles of the said Lectureships as follows :—

2. The Holders of the following part-time Lectureships shall carry out the duties of the Lectureships as follows :—
  - Lectureship in Surgery—under the direction of the Professor of Surgery.
  - Lectureship in Pathology—under the direction of the Professor of Pathology.
3. The holder of each of the foregoing two Part-time Lectureships shall subject to good conduct and to the due fulfilment of his duties hold office for seven years after which he shall be eligible for re-appointment. If reappointed he shall subject to good conduct and the due fulfilment of his duties hold office until he shall have attained the age of sixty-five years and may thereafter be continued in office for five further years : PROVIDED that such further continuance in office is recommended to the Senate of the National University of Ireland by the Governing Body with the approval of the President and is sanctioned annually by the said Senate.
4. The holder of each of the foregoing two Part-time Lectureships shall be entitled to the annual allowances in respect of children payable in pursuance to Statute XXXVII, Statute LV and Statute LXXV of University College, Galway.
5. The holder of the Part-time Professorship of Psychiatry, the holder of the Part-time Lectureship in Pathology and the holder of the Part-time Lectureship in Surgery, shall be required to give clinical instruction to the Undergraduate and Post-

graduate students of the College at such hours and in such hospitals as the Academic Council may proscribe subject to review by the Governing Body.

## CHAPTER V

1. Nothing herein contained shall affect any appointment made right acquired or act done under any previous Statute of the College.
2. This Statute shall come into operation on the Nineteenth day of June, One Thousand Nine Hundred and sixty-nine and may be cited as Statute LXXIX, University College, Galway, or Stat. LXXIX, Univ. Coll., Galway.
