STATUTE LX

WE, the Governing Body of University College, Galway, under and by virtue of the powers in that behalf conferred on us by the above Acts DO by this present instrument under the Seal of University College, Galway, make the Statute contained in the Schedule hereto for the general government of the said College.

Given under the Common Seal of University College, Galway, this Twenty-third day of March, 1965.

SCHEDULE--STATUTE LX

All previous Statutes of University College, Galway, shall be read and construed with the alterations, additions and modifications hereinafter set forth.

CHAPTER I

THE LIBRARIAN

1. The office of Librarian shall henceforth be a full-time office. The Librarian shall not be at the same time a Professor, Lecturer or Assistant in the College nor shall he hold any other office of profit or employment without the prior sanction of the Governing Body.

2. The Librarian shall be appointed by the Governing Body following consideration of the Report of the Academic Council on the Candidates for the Post; the Librarian shall be removable by the Governing Body.

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in Chapter XIX of Statute XVII of University College, Galway the Librarian need not be selected from the Professors and Lecturers of the College.

3. The Librarian shall be entitled to hold office until he shall have attained the age of sixty-five years. After attaining the said age a Librarian may be continued in office by the Governing Body from year to year for a period not exceeding five years PROVIDED that such further continuance in office is recommended to the Governing Body by the President.

4. The Librarian shall discharge the duties which are prescribed by Regulations and shall do and perform all other acts and duties in relation to the College as by the Statutes or Regulations he may be required to do and perform.

5. The Librarian shall attend at the Library at such times as the Governing Body shall prescribe.

6. The salary of the Librarian shall be £1,700 on appointment increasing to a maximum of £2,400 by annual increments of £70 for each completed year of service since appointment. The Governing Body may in its discretion and if the President (having regard to the qualifications and experience, if any, of the person appointed) so recommends fix the commencing salary at any point in the incremental salary scale applicable to the office.

7 (a) The office of Librarian shall be a pensionable office within the meaning of Chapter XXV of Statute XVII of University College, Galway and the amendments thereto and shall be annexed to the appropriate table of the Pension Scheme.

(b) Pension and Gratuity shall be calculated and paid in accordance with the provisions of Chapters II and III of Statute XXXVI of University College, Galway and the Statutes of the College.

(c) There shall be paid into the Pension Fund such additional sum as an Actuary shall certify to be necessary for providing such pension and gratuity as aforesaid.

(d) The annual salary for the purpose of calculating pension and gratuity in accordance with the relevant provisions of existing Statutes of the College shall be deemed to be that payable at date of retirement or death.

8. The Librarian shall be entitled to the annual allowances in respect of a wife and children payable pursuant to Statute XXXVII and Statute LV of University College, Galway.

CHAPTER II

1. Nothing herein contained shall affect any appointment made right acquired or act done under any previous Statute of the College.

2. This Statute shall come into operation on the Twenty-third day of March, 1965 and may be cited as Statute LX University College, Galway or Stat. LX. Univ. Coll., Galway.
