STATUTE L.

WE, the Governing Body of University College, Galway, under and by virtue of the powers in that behalf conferred on us by the above Acts, Do by this present Instrument under the Seal of University College, Galway, make the Statute contained in the Schedule hereto for the general government of the said College.

Given under the Common Seal of University College, Galway, this Twenty-third day of May, 1961.

SCHEDULE—STATUTE L

All previous Statutes of University College, Galway, shall be read and construed with the alterations, additions and modifications hereinafter set forth.

CHAPTER I

NEW FULL-TIME LECTURESHIPS

1. There shall be established in this College in the event of their institution by the Senate of the National University of Ireland, nine full-time Lectureships as follows:—

- (i) A Lectureship (No. 2) in Mathematics. The holder shall carry out the duties of the Lectureship under the direction of the Professor of Mathematics.
- (ii) A Lectureship in English Language and English Literature. The holder shall carry out the duties of the Lectureship under the direction of the Professor of English Language and English Literature.
- (iii) A Lectureship (No. 2) in Civil Engineering. The holder shall carry out the duties of the Lectureship under the direction of the Professor of Civil Engineering.
- (iv) A Lectureship in Physical Chemistry. The holder shall carry out the duties of the Lectureship under the direction of the Professor of Chemistry.
- (v) A Lectureship (No. 2) in Experimental Physics. The holder shall carry out the duties of the Lectureship under the direction of the Professor of Experimental Physics.
- (vi) A Lectureship (No. 2) in Mathematical Physics. The holder shall carry out the duties of the Lectureship under the direction of the Professor of Mathematical Physics.

- (vii) A Lectureship in Biochemistry.
- (viii) A Lectureship in History (with special reference to Medieval History). The holder shall carry out the duties of the Lectureship under the direction of the Professor of History.
- (ix) A Lectureship in Geography. The holder of the Lectureship shall carry out the duties of the Lectureship under the direction of the Professor of Geology.

2. The annual stipend of the holder of each of the foregoing Lectureships shall be £1,080 on appointment, increasing to a maximum of £1,584 by annual increments of £72 for each completed year of service since appointment, subject to the provisions, where applicable, as to reckoning years of service set forth in Section 5 of Table "A" to Chapter I of Statute XXXVII of University College, Galway, and as to added years set forth in Chapter III of Statute XLII of University College, Galway.

3. The holder of each of the foregoing Lectureships shall, subject to good conduct and to the due fulfilment of his duties, hold office for seven years after which he shall be eligible for re-appointment. If re-appointed, he shall, subject to good conduct and the due fulfilment of his duties, hold office until he shall have attained the age of sixty-five years and may thereafter be continued in office for five further years: *Provided* that such further continuance in office is recommended to the Senate of the National University of Ireland by the Governing Body of University College, Galway, with the approval of the President of the said College, and is sanctioned annually by the said Senate.

4. The foregoing nine Lectureships shall be pensionable offices within the meaning of Chapter XXV of Statute XVII of University College, Galway, and the amendments thereto and shall be annexed to the appropriate Table of the Pension Scheme. In each case pension and gratuity shall be calculated and paid in accordance with the provisions of Chapters II and III of Statute XXXVI of University College, Galway and the Statutes of the College. There shall be paid into the Pension Fund such additional sum as an actuary shall certify to be necessary for providing such pension and gratuity as aforesaid. The annual stipend for the purpose of calculating Pension and Gratuity in accordance with the relevant provisions of existing Statutes of the College shall in every case be deemed to be that payable at the date of death or retirement of the holder pursuant to the provisions of Section 2 of this Chapter.

5. The holder of each of the foregoing nine Lectureships shall be entitled to the annual allowances in respect of a wife and children payable pursuant to Section 6 of Chapter I of Statute XXXVII of University College, Galway.

## CHAPTER II

### NEW PART-TIME LECTURESHIPS

1. There shall be established in the College in the event of their institution by the Senate of the National University of Ireland, two part-time non-pensionable Lectureships as follows:—

- (i) A Lectureship in Radiology.
- (ii) A Lectureship in Applied Physiology.

2. The Stipend of the Lectureship in Radiology shall be £100 per annum.

3. The Stipend of the Lectureship in Applied Physiology shall be £100 per annum.

4. The holders of the two foregoing part-time Lectureships shall hold office for the same term subject to the same conditions as is prescribed for full-time Lecturers of the College.

5. The provisions of the Statutes for payment of pension gratuity and wife and children allowances shall not apply to the two foregoing Lectureships.

6. The holder of the Lectureship in Radiology shall be required to give clinical instruction to the medical students of the College at such hours and in such Hospitals as the Academic Council may prescribe subject to review by the Governing Body.

#### CHAPTER III

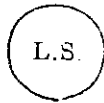
1. The duties of the several Lectureships established by this Statute as regards amount and allocation of work may be hereafter more fully defined by regulations of the Governing Body.

#### CHAPTER IV

1. Nothing herein contained shall affect any appointment made, right acquired, liability incurred or act done under any previous Statute of the College.

2. This Statute shall come into operation on the Twenty-third day of May, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-one and may be cited as Statute L, University College, Galway or Stat. L., Univ. Coll. Galway.
