STATUTE XLVIII.

WE, the Governing Body of University College, Galway, under and by virtue of the powers in that behalf conferred on us by the above Acts, Do by this present instrument under the Seal of University College, Galway, make the Statute contained in the Schedule hereto for the general government of the said College.

SCHEDULE—STATUTE XLVIII.

All previous Statutes of University College, Galway, shall be read and construed with the alterations, additions and modifications hereinafter set forth.

CHAPTER I.

THE BURSAR.

1. Notwithstanding anything contained in Statute XLVI of University College, Galway, or in any previous Statute of the College the annual stipend of the Bursar payable as from the 1st day of April 1959 shall be £500.
2. For the purpose of calculating the amount of pension payable on retirement of the present holder of the Professorship of Education the annual stipend payable at date of retirement shall be deemed to be £2,660.
3. For the purpose of calculating the amount of the gratuity payable on the death or retirement of the present holder of the Professorship of Education the annual stipend payable at the date of death or retirement shall be deemed to be £2,660.

CHAPTER II.

THE REGISTRAR AND SECRETARY.

1. Notwithstanding anything contained in Statute XLVI of University College, Galway, or in any previous Statute of the College there shall be paid to the Registrar and Secretary, as from the 1st day of April 1959 (in addition to his present annual stipend of £650) a pensionable allowance of £360 per annum in lieu of house, fire, and light.

2. For the purpose of calculating the amount of pension payable on retirement of the present holder of the Professorship of Geology including Physical Geography and Mineralogy the annual stipend payable at date of retirement shall be deemed to be £3,170.

3. For the purpose of calculating the amount of the gratuity payable on the death or retirement of the present holder of the Professorship of Geology including Physical Geography and Mineralogy the annual stipend payable at the date of death or retirement shall be deemed to be £3,170.

CHAPTER III.

THE PROFESSORSHIP OF OPHTHALMOLOGY AND OTO-RHINOLARYNGOLOGY.

1. The Professorship of Ophthalmology and Oto-Rhinolaryngology is hereby extinguished.

2. There shall be in the College (on such Lectureships being instituted within the College by the Senate of the National University of Ireland) the two following part-time non-pensionable Lectureships :—

- (i) The Lectureship in Ophthalmology.
- (ii) The Lectureship in Oto-Rhinolaryngology.

3. The stipend of the Lectureship in Ophthalmology shall be £260 per annum.

4. The stipend of the Lectureship in Oto-Rhinolaryngology shall be £260 per annum.

5. The holders of the two foregoing Lectureships shall (in addition to such other duties as may be prescribed) give clinical instruction to the medical students of the College at such hours and in such hospitals as the Academic Council may prescribe, subject to review by the Governing Body.

CHAPTER IV.

This Statute shall come into operation on the Twenty-third day of November, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty and may be cited as Statute XLVIII of University College, Galway, or Stat. XLVIII Univ. Coll., Galway.
