STATUTE XXVIII.

WE, the Governing Body of University College, Galway, under and by virtue of the powers in that behalf conferred on us by the above Act, DO by this present Instrument under the Seal of University College, Galway, make the Statute in the Schedule hereof for the general government of the said College.

SCHEDULE

STATUTE XXVIII.

1. All previous Statutes of University College Galway shall be read and construed with the alterations additions and modifications hereinafter set forth.

2. Whereas it appears from actuarial investigation that the amount of the Pension Fund exceeds the amount estimated by the Actuary as being necessary to secure the solvency of the Fund the excess shall be utilized in accordance with Statute XVII Cap. 25 for the provision of increased pensions for pensionable officers as herein provided.

3. The following provisions of previous Statutes are revoked: -

- (a) Subsections (1) to (9) of Section 2 of Statute XXIV (wherein is provided the present basis of calculation of pensions payable to certain Professors and Lecturers).
- (b) Subsections (1) to (9) of Section 3 of the said Statute XXIV (wherein certain amendments of the Pension Scheme are provided).
- (c) Sections 3 (a) and 4 (a) of Statute XXV (wherein is provided the basis of calculation of Pensions payable to certain Lecturers).

4. The annual pension payable to each of the holders of the several Professorships Lectureships and offices set out in Column I of the Table at the end of this Statute under the heading "Office" shall in all cases be a sum computed by multiplying a seventieth part of The Stipend by the number of years of service of the holder.

5. The Stipend of any Professorship Lectureship or Office for the purposes of the foregoing calculation shall be deemed to be the relevant sum set forth in every case in Column II of the Table under the heading "The Stipend--Present Holder" except as is hereinafter provided.

6. Where in the case of a future holder of any Professorship Lectureship or Office a different stipend is to form the basis of calculation of pension such different stipend if any is set forth in Column III of the Table under the heading "The Stipend—Future Holder."

7. The Stipend for the purpose of calculating pension or otherwise of any Professorship or Lectureship during any period when the Holder is also President shall be two-thirds only of the Stipend attached to such Professorship or Lectureship as prescribed for the time being by the Statutes of the College.

8. In the case of the present holder of the Office of President the Stipend for the purpose of calculating pension for years of service prior to 25th October 1934 is £80.

9. Years of service shall be reckoned from the date of appointment to a Professorship Lectureship or Office set forth in Column I of the Table or to any Professorship Lectureship or Office (now extinguished) which was heretofore pensionable. Years of service shall be added as provided by Section 9 of Chapter 25 of Statute XVII. Section 3 and Section 7 of the Pension Scheme in the said Chapter 25 of Statute XVII shall continue to apply.

10. Nothing herein contained shall be deemed to alter the number of years of service of any particular holder of a Professorship Lectureship or Office as already defined by Statute XXIV or any other Statute of the College.

11. In the case of the present holder of the Professorship of Mathematical Physics there shall be taken into account in addition to service as such Professor six years of service as Lecturer in Mathematics through Irish. The Stipend for the said period of six years for the purpose of calculating pension in this instance is £500.

12. The method of calculation provided by Section 2 hereof shall be applied in calculating the pension payable to the present Emeritus Professor of Philosophy. The Stipend in this instance for the purpose of calculating pension payable from the date of operation of this Statute is £775.

13. This Statute shall have no application to gratuities.

14. Nothing herein contained shall affect any appointment made right acquired or act done under any previous Statute of the College.

15. This Statute shall come into operation on the Twenty-ninth day of April, 1941, and may be cited as Statute XXVIII University College Galway or Stat. XXVIII of Univ. Coll. Galway.
