STATUTE XXXI.

WE the Governing Body of University College Galway under and by virtue of the Powers in that behalf conferred on us by the above Acts DO by this present instrument under the Seal of University College Galway make the Statute contained in the Schedule hereof for the General Government of the said College.

SCHEDULE STATUTE XXXI.

1. All previous Statutes of University College Galway shall be read and construed with the additions, modifications, and amendments hereinafter set forth.

2. Two full-time Lectureships are hereby instituted as follows:—

- (i) A Lectureship in Civil Engineering,
- (ii) A Lectureship in Electrical Technology, Applied Heat, and Mathematics.

The Lectureship in Civil Engineering shall not be filled until the resignation of the present Assistant in Civil Engineering conditional on his appointment to the Lectureship in Civil Engineering or until the Assistantship in Civil Engineering shall become otherwise vacant.

The Lectureship in Electrical Technology, Applied Heat and Mathematics shall not be filled until the resignation of the present Assistant in Electrical Engineering and Mathematics conditional on his appointment to the Lectureship in Electrical Technology, Applied Heat and Mathematics or until the Assistantship in Electrical Engineering and Mathematics shall become otherwise vacant.

3. The stipend of the holder of the Lecturship in Civil Engineering shall be £500 per annum. The holder of the Lectureship shall carry out his duties subject to the direction of the Professor of Civil Engineering.

4. The stipend of the holder of the Lectureship in Electrical Technology, Applied Heat and Mathematics, shall be £500 per annum. The holder of the Lectureship shall carry out his duties, so far as the same relate to Electrical Technology and Applied Heat, subject to the direction of the Professor of Civil Engineering, and so far as the same relate to Mathematics, subject to the direction of the Professor of Mathematics.

5. The duties of the holder of each of the foregoing Lectureships, as regards amount and allocation of work, may be hereafter more fully defined by Regulations of the Governing Body.

6. Both the foregoing Lectureships shall be Pensionable Offices within the meaning of Chapter XXV of Statute XVII, and the amendments thereto. Both Lectureships shall be annexed to Table B. of the Pension Scheme. The stipend for Pension purposes of either Office within the meaning of Statute XXVIII University College Galway shall be in the case of a present or future holder £500.

7. Sub-section 10. of Sec. 3. of Statute XXIV is hereby amended by the insertion after Paragraph V thereof, of a new paragraph as follows that is to say:—

- (10) V. (B). £50 to the Lecturers in (a) Civil Engineering, (b) Electrical Technology, Applied Heat, and Mathematics, and the years of service for the purpose of gratuity of the holders shall be counted from the date of their appointment to the Lectureships.

8. On the appointment of any Assistant in the College to either of the foregoing Lectureships, the services and right to stipend of such Assistant shall absolutely determine.

9. Nothing herein contained shall affect any appointment made, right acquired, liability incurred, or act done under any previous Statute of the College.

10. This Statute shall come into operation on the second day of July, 1946, and may be cited as Statute XXXI of University College Galway, or Stat. XXXI Univ. Coll. Galway.
