STATUTE XXXVI.

We the Governing Body of University College, Galway, under and by virtue of the powers in that behalf conferred on us by the above Acts Do by this present instrument under the Seal of University College, Galway, make the Statute contained in the Schedule hereof for the general government of the said College.

SCHEDULE—STATUTE XXXVI.

All previous Statutes of University College, Galway, shall be read and construed with the alterations, additions and modifications hereinafter set forth.

CHAPTER I.—PENSION FUND.

1. In lieu of the sum of £1,410 hitherto paid annually into the Pension Fund, there shall henceforth be paid and transferred to the Pension Fund out of the annual income granted by the Oireachtas for the general purposes of the College or out of any other moneys of the College applicable thereto the following sums at the times herein specified :—

- (i) on or before the 31st July, 1950, the sum of £4,410,
- (ii) on or before the 31st July in each succeeding year thereafter the sum of £4,410.

Section 2 of Chapter XXV of Statute XVII of University College, Galway, is hereby amended accordingly.

CHAPTER II.—PENSIONS.

1. The annual pension payable to the President and to the holders of each of the Professorships, Lectureships and Offices set out in the Table to this Statute under the heading "The

Office' shall henceforth in all cases be a sum calculated by multiplying a sixtieth part of the stipend by the number of years of service of the holder.

2. The stipend for the purposes of the foregoing calculation shall be deemed to be the relevant sum set forth in every case in column II of the Table under the heading 'The Stipend.' In the case, however, of the present holder of the Professorship of Geology, including Physical Geography and Mineralogy, and the present holder of the Professorship of Education, the stipend for the purpose of calculating pension shall be taken to be :—

(i) of the present holder of the Professorship of Geology, including Physical Geography and Mineralogy, £1,450;

(ii) of the present holder of the Professorship of Education, £1,205.

3. Pensions on retirement whether on the ground of age, ill-health, or incapacity from infirmity of mind and body, shall be paid only after ten actual years of service in accordance with the existing Pension Scheme.

4. Years of service shall be reckoned from the date of appointment to the office of President or to a pensionable Professorship, Lectureship or Office in the College and seven years shall be added in the manner provided by Section 9 of Chapter XXV of Statute XVII of University College, Galway.

5. In case the holder of any pensionable position in the College shall vacate such position by reason of appointment to another pensionable position within the College, the pension of such person shall (notwithstanding Sections 1 and 2 of this Chapter) be calculated upon the stipend of the former position for the actual years of service in such position and upon the subsequent stipend for the actual years of service in that subsequent position, provided that for the qualification of ten actual years of service ten years of service jointly in such positions shall be sufficient.

6. The present holders of the Professorship of Modern Irish and the Professorship of Mathematical Physics shall be entitled to have counted in accordance with Section 5 of this Chapter their years of service as Lecturer in Modern Irish and Lecturer in Mathematics respectively. The stipend in both cases for the period between the date of appointment as Lecturer and date of appointment as Professor shall for the purpose of calculating pension be taken to be £850.

7. The method of calculation provided by Section 1 of this Chapter shall be applied so as to provide increase of pension in the case of each of the following :—

- (1) The retired Professor of Pathology.
- (2) The retired Professor of Civil Engineering.
- (3) The retired Lady Superintendent.

In these three instances, however, the basis of calculation of the increased pensions payable shall be the stipends set forth in the Table to Statute XXVIII of University College, Galway. The increased pensions so calculated shall become payable from the date of coming into operation of this Statute.

#### CHAPTER III.—GRATUITIES.

1. In addition to Pensions there shall be paid out of the Pension Fund to the President and to the holder of any Professorship, Lectureship or Office set out in the Table to this Statute on retirement or to his or her personal representative in the case of death a gratuity as hereinafter provided.

2. The gratuity shall be computed upon the basis of one-tenth of the stipend for each year of actual service in the College provided that

- (a) gratuities shall be paid only after five actual years of service in the College in a pensionable office;
- (b) the maximum number of years to be taken into account when calculating the amount of gratuity shall be ten.

3. The stipend for the purpose of calculating the amount of gratuity as aforesaid shall be deemed to be the relevant sum set forth in every case in column II of the Table under the heading 'The Stipend.' In the case, however, of the present holder of the Professorship of Geology including Physical Geography and Mineralogy and the present holder of the Professorship of Education the stipend for the purpose of calculating the amount of the gratuity shall be taken to be the respective sums set forth in Section 2 of Chapter II of this Statute.

#### CHAPTER IV.

1. Nothing herein contained shall affect any appointment made right acquired liability incurred or act done under any previous Statute of the College.

2. This Statute shall come into operation on the Thirtieth day of October, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty, and may be cited as Statute XXXVI of University College, Galway, or Stat. XXXVI Univ. Coll., Galway.
