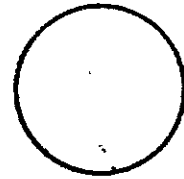

STATUTE XXXV.

WE, the Governing Body of University College Galway under and by virtue of the powers in that behalf conferred on us by the above Acts DO by this present instrument under the Seal of University College Galway, make the Statute contained in the Schedule hereof for the general government of the said College.

SCHEDULE—STATUTE XXXV.

All previous Statutes of University College Galway shall be read and construed with the additions, modifications, and amendments hereinafter set forth.

CHAPTER I.

1. For the purpose of maintaining a Register of the Graduates who are Members of the College and for the purpose of the election by the Graduates of the Members of the Governing Body whom the Graduates are entitled to elect the following provisions (to be construed with Chapter VI. Statute XVII and with Statute XXI. of University College Galway) shall apply.

CHAPTER 2.—CHANGES OF ADDRESS OF GRADUATE MEMBERS OF THE COLLEGE.

1. The Registrar shall, not less than three months before the expiration of the period of office of the Governing Body, give public notice once in the daily newspapers and once in a local newspaper that changes of address in the Register of Graduate Members must be notified on or before a fixed date, viz: —the latest date for nomination.

2. Graduate Members of the College desiring to have their addresses changed in the Register of Graduate Members shall furnish to the Registrar a Notice of Change of address signed by them containing their new addresses, full names, and Degrees (with date of conferring for purpose of identification).

3. Such Notice may be in the following form:—

4. Changes of address in the Register of Graduate Members shall be made by the Registrar at any time but only on receipt of Notice of Change of Address or its equivalent duly signed by the Graduate. No such change shall, however, be made (on the occasion of an election to the Governing Body by the Graduates) during the period between the latest date for nomination and the date of the Election Meeting.

5. The Notice of Election to be given to Graduate Members (as prescribed by Section 1 of Chapter VI of Statute XVII of University College, Galway) shall be accompanied by the above Form of Notice of Change of Address. The Notice of Election shall in-

timate to the Graduate the latest date for nomination, and that changes of address must be notified to the Registrar on or before such date.

CHAPTER 3.—ELECTION BY THE GRADUATES.

1. For the purpose of the Election by the Graduates of Members of the Governing Body, the Registrar shall prepare and shall send by post not less than 10 days before the Election Meeting, to each registered Graduate no matter where resident, a Voting Paper containing in dictionary order the names of all candidates validly nominated for election by the Graduates.

2. It shall no longer be necessary that the printed paper of instructions which accompanies a Voting Paper shall contain "a Statement of the names of the graduates nominating each person nominated." The Voting Paper shall, however, contain the names of not more than four Graduates nominating each candidate.

3. The names of the four nominating Graduates to be published on the Voting Paper may be selected by the candidate from the list of valid nominations received. In default of such selection by the candidate by the end of the latest date for nomination, the Registrar shall include on the Voting Paper as Nominating Graduates, the names appearing on the first two valid Nomination Papers received.

CHAPTER 4.

1. This Statute shall come into operation on the Ninth day of February, 1949 and may be cited as Statute XXXV University College Galway or Stat. XXXV Univ. Coll. Galway.
