

Language Requirement	Valid Proof of English Language Proficiency (Official TOEFL, IELTS or Duolingo results). Minimum 85 IBT and at least 20 on each subsection; Minimum 6.5 IELTS with at least 6.5 on each subsection; or Minimum 115 Duolingo with at least 105 on each section.	
	Students who are completing an undergraduate degree at a university in country where English is the official language or from the American College of Thessaloniki, and Yale-NUS are not required to fulfill this requirement.

Important Additional Costs

Students must be able to meet the following costs as they apply to their particular situation:

- * SEVIS and J1 visa fees currently \$380
- * Travel expenses between home country and Washington DC, and during vacation periods
- * Large purchases (such as computers, furniture, etc...)
- * Medical expenses not covered by health insurance (eye care, dental care, or Medical problems developed before arriving at the university)
