
'Find A Supervisor'

IRIS now has a live feed on the Courses section of the external website <http://www.nuigalway.ie/findasupervisor/> which can be viewed externally to help identify potential supervisors and their key research interests.

Step 1 Research Interests for eProspectus

In this step you can enter the information you wish to appear in the research interests section of the eprospectus feed.

Select **'Research Information'** on the vertical menu bar on the left hand side of the screen and then select **'Research Interests for eProspectus'** and enter your information. Click on **'Save Changes'** before leaving this screen.
